To whom it may concern,

ODFW has assessed the information provided by the John Day Fossil Beds National Monument staff for two proposed temporary transfers involving Certificates 81943 and 96945. The transfers must provide a net benefit to fish and wildlife habitat to receive an ODFW endorsement for the fee reduction offered through the Oregon Water Resources Department.

For these temporary transfers, it is ODFW's understanding that the proposals involve discontinuing diversion from Rock Creek under Certificates 85366 and 88400, which will both be concurrently leased instream. The irrigation diversion from Certificates 81943 and 96945 will be moved downstream on the John Day River mainstem approximately one mile.

Therefore, ODFW has determined that the proposed transfer provides a net benefit to fish and wildlife habitat due to the following actions, qualifying for OWRD's fee reduction:

- Downstream movement of Certificates 81943 and 96945, providing an increase of water instream for approximately one mile between the original POD and the new downstream POD in the John Day River
- Instream lease of Certificates 85366 and 88400 (and potentially others) providing more flow at the mouth of Rock Creek and the John Day River
- Discontinuation of the Rock Creek withdrawals aiding in fish passage at the diversion site, particularly during spring and summer


