*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs ($x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs$).
 - If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

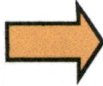

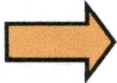

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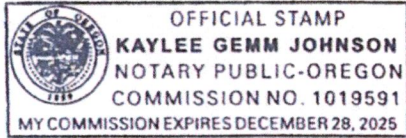

The following statement *in italics* was written by Denny Elmer, current owner of the FROM lands.

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this letter to describe how I know the water right on my property (certificate 15148) has been used within the last five years. I purchased the property at 985 SE Sheridan Rd. Sheridan, Oregon. I believe we closed on in October 20, 2020.

During the 3 months prior to closing on this property I visited and inspected the property many times. The previous owner had a large orchard area, and a very large garden area and the rest was several smaller pastures that they ran some animals on. They had a pump and a long pipe that ran down into the river at the western corner that they used for irrigating all of the areas on the property. I remember seeing pipes and hoses running to all the areas that they were watering.

We had to remove some of that while we were doing construction on the area that will become used for RV's. We did use the irrigation system for a while during construction.

I was told by someone at Water Resources, at that time, that I would be able to use it for irrigation of all the lawns at the future RV Park, but in the end, we ended up putting in a system connected to the city water. Now that we have confirmed, the system works, and is adequate, we are willing to part with our current water rights.

I have this picture of the pump that was on the bank near the river that was used for this water right.
