The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the volume of water diverted, and may require the water user to report water-use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right.
- D. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.
