confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 467.3 ACRES, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The dates of priority are 1892, 1895, 1897, 1898, and 1904/1910.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 5.84 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

Dear Ms. Hubert:

We represent the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon ("Tribe"). Deschutes River Conservancy ("DRC"), on behalf of certain property owners, has provided the Tribe with certain information concerning a proposed instream lease identified in **Appendix A** hereto (the "Lease"), which Lease proposes to lease water for instream purposes.

On June 3, 2024, the Tribe previously submitted a letter not objecting to the Lease based on DRC's representation of a 65-100 acreage scope of the Lease. On June 17, 2024, the Tribe again submitted a letter not objecting to the Lease based on DRC's representation of a 50.16 acreage scope of the Lease. The Tribe has now reviewed the further-revised Lease, with a decreased acreage scope as depicted in **Appendix A** hereto, and provides this supplemental letter to DRC. To be clear, the Tribe hereby withdraws its prior June 3 and June 17 letters referenced above, and replaces both prior letters with this revised letter dated June 21, 2024.

The Tribe has reviewed the information about the Lease provided by DRC. The Tribe is relying in good faith upon the information provided by DRC. Based on that information, the Tribe does not object to the Department of Water Resources ("Department") processing the Lease in accordance with applicable law, and the Department's customary practice. The Tribe, however, expressly reserves, and does not waive, all rights, claims, and defenses that it may possess in connection with the Lease, including, but not limited to, whether the Lease violates the Treaty of June 25, 1855, with the Tribes of Middle Oregon, 12 Stat. 963, or the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation Water Rights Settlement Agreement, dated November 17, 1997, as amended.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PEOPLES IRRIGATION CO. 615221 O'NEIL HIGHWAY PRINEVILLE, OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 467.3 ACRES, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The dates of priority are 1892, 1895, 1897, 1898, and 1904/1910.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 5.84 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.
