The overall water right transfer is summarized on Attachment 1.

For Cert 12746, transfer the point(s) of diversion and places of use from the South Fork Walla Walla River (Place of Use A owned by Jensen) downstream to Place of Use B owned by Cayuse and served by the Walla Walla River Irrigation District and Hudson Bay District Improvement Company to get the 1880 priority date on high-value agricultural land.

For Cert 97646, transfer the place of use only (no change to point of diversion) for the primary water right from Place of Use B (Cayuse) to Place of Use C (also Cayuse) for optimal use of this priority date. This water right is served by the Walla Walla River Irrigation District.

For Cert 93399, transfer the place of use only (no change to point of diversion) for the primary water right from Place of Use C (Cayuse) to Places of Use D (Leber) and E (Hendricks). This water right is served by the Hudson Bay District Improvement Company.
