Re: Updates to Transfer Application T-13777, in the name of Amazon Data Services, Inc.

Dear Dante:

On July 8, 2021, GSI submitted Transfer Application T-13777 on behalf of Amazon Data Services, Inc. (Applicant). Transfer T-13777 requests changes to five water right certificates, including changing the character of use, place of use and point of appropriation for all of Certificate 53194 and a portion of Certificate 53193. On April 8, 2022, GSI submitted revisions to the application related to updating the location for Proposed Well 1 and adding a Proposed Well 2 for Certificates 53193 and 53194. The Oregon Water Resources Department's (OWRD's) groundwater review for the application concluded that the proposed points of appropriation were not within the same aquifer as the authorized point of appropriation. On May 15, 2023, GSI submitted revisions to the transfer application to request a new location for Proposed Well 1 and eliminate Proposed Well 2. OWRD's groundwater review for the revised application concluded that the proposed point of appropriation would not appropriate groundwater from the same aquifer as the authorized point of proposed Well 1 and eliminate Proposed Well 2.

GSI is submitting the enclosed application pages to modify the proposed construction for Proposed Well 1. The changes are intended to resolve OWRD's concern regarding the aquifer from which the proposed well will appropriate groundwater. New and revised information is attached and highlighted to show what has been revised - the target aquifer is revised to clearly specify the flowtop of the Pomona Member (CRBG). Please replace the original transfer application pages with the enclosed pages. These requested updates do <u>not</u> change the source of water or increase the appurtenant area under these water rights.

The Applicant is <u>not</u> requesting Reimbursement Authority processing of this transfer application moving forward.
