1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: The applicant is converting the property into an RV resort and is proposing to change the character of use from "Mining and Industrial" to "Primary Irrigation". The applicant is also changing the point of appropriation to a location approximately 160' northwest of the authorized point of appropriation.

The applicant is proposing to transfer 0.12 cubic foot per second to each acre of land being transferred to "Primary Irrigation". 13.69 acres of land within the authorized use boundary for "Mining/Industrial Use" will have its authorized rate transferred to the new "Primary Irrigation" lands.

The authorized point of appropriation was mistakenly stated as being in SW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 18; however, the actual location is in the NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 18. This transfer will change the POA location to the correct quarter-quarter.
