

Additional remarks: Tax Lot 1602 results from a consolidation of Tax Lot 1602 - listed on cert as "Bend-City of Tumalo Fire Station" AND Tax Lot 1700 - listed on cert as "Scott, Steve". The TL 1602 portion will retain 0.118 ac IR, the former TL 1700 will retain 0.03 ac. IR, however, due to the consolidation, the entirety (0.118 ac. + 0.03 ac. = 0.148 ac.) of the remaining right will be appurtenant to TL 1602. The two domestic uses associated with the "OFF" lands are being changed to Tax Lot 5205 - owned by "K & T Roark, LLC" and Tax Lot 5200 5207 – owned by "Paul, Brek Daniel et al.".
