Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 536.750 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the use, place of use or point of diversion of water in the event of a declaration of drought, without complying with the notice and waiting requirements under ORS 540.520. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 019 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating drought transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- On April 21, 2022, ROBERT L UNRUH filed an application to temporarily change the places
 of use and change the points of appropriation under Certificate 27103, 74458, and Permit
 G-12450 for the remainder of the 2022 irrigation season or the term of the Governor's
 declared drought, whichever is shorter. The Department assigned the application number
 T-13987.
- Notice of the application for transfer was published on May 3, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- On June 9, 2022, the Department approved Drought Temporary Transfer Application T-13987, as evidenced in Special Order Volume 125, Pages 238-243.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On July 15, 2022, the Department sent a Reconsideration Letter because the Final Order was issued prior to the Department's Groundwater review being completed.
- 5. On July 22, 2022, the Department completed the Groundwater Review and found the change in point of appropriation was from the same source and that there was no finding of injury. 

Temporary Drought Transfer Review Criteria

- Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 14. The Governor issued an executive order on March 4; 2022; declaring a state of drought emergency in Klamath County due to drought and extreme weather conditions, which is still in effect and the water right proposed for transfer is on lands included in the area covered by the drought order.
- 15. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 16. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under OAR 690-019-055(3) if injury to existing water rights is shown and cannot be mitigated to the satisfaction of the Director and injured parties.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary change in places of use and points of appropriation proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13987 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0055.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The temporary change in in places of use and points of appropriation proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13987 are approved.
- The former places of use shall not be irrigated as part of these water rights during the remainder of the 2022 irrigation season or until the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.
- The approval of this temporary drought transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- The use of water at the temporary places of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 27103, 74458, and Permit G-12450. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2022 irrigation season.
- The proposed change in places of use and points of appropriation shall revert to the authorized places of use and points of appropriation at the end of the 2022 irrigation season or the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.
- The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificate 27103, 74458, and Permit G-12450 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 27103, 74458, and Permit G-12450.
