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*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (*for C12345, 1.25 cfs ÷ 100 ac*); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (*x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs*).
 - If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (*For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs*)

North Unit Irrigation District is requesting to change the authorized place of use for a 4-acre portion of Certificate 72280 (for irrigation purposes), and a 4- acre portion of Certificate 72282 (for supplemental irrigation). The rights are held by North Unit Irrigation District (NUID). The authorized place of use is outside the NUID boundary and proposed place of use is located inside the NUID boundary.

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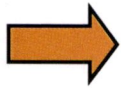

Description of Water Delivery System System capacity: 1,100 cubic feet per second (cfs)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines, and sprinklers used to divert, convey, and apply the water at the authorized place of use. North Unit Irrigation District diverts water into a main canal in Bend that conveys water by gravity north, approximately 26 miles where it crosses the Crooked River in an enclosed box flume to the fields and farms in Jefferson County. The main canal provides deliveries to individual patrons between the Crooked River and Haystack Reservoir, a re-regulating reservoir. The northern portion of the district is served by water from Deschutes River and Haystack Reservoir, through additional main canal and laterals throughout the irrigation district boundary. The property was irrigated by delivery from the NUID 51 lateral, where it was pumped into a wheel-line sprinkler system.

The property was irrigated by delivery from the NUID 51 lateral, where it was pumped into a wheel-line sprinkler system.
