- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. On behalf of applicants Seth H. Beck and Larissa Beck, we are providing notification of intent to transfer a water right to instream use. The transfer application is requesting to change a portion of water right certificate 95746 to instream use. The portion of the water right consists of an irrigation use on 2.5 acres in Tax Lot 800 (located in the SE ¼ of the SW ¼, Section 3, T23S R10E, W.M.).

The proposed transfer will place up to 0.063 cubic feet per second instream with an 1897 priority date from April 1 to October 31. We have requested that the water be protected from the authorized Little Deschutes River Point of Diversion (located in the SW ¼ of the SW ¼, Section 34, T23S R9E, W.M.), to the mouth of the Little Deschutes River, into the Deschutes River down to Lake Billy Chinook (~River Mile 120).
