NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law all water belongs to the public IORS 537.110l. In almost every instance, a permit ("water right") from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting, or storing any water IORS 537.130l. However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, ORS 537.330 requires persons selling property that has a water right to:

1) provide evidence of the water right to the buyer and 2) notify the Water Resources Department of the water right involved with the real estate transaction. Sellers are exempted from this requirement if the water uses are served by a water district or a city.


Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.







There appears a discrepancy between the amount of acres described in this transfer (63.6) and the amount of acres described on Certificate 33836 (66.6). This leaves 3.0 acres unaccounted for. Does this mean that they will loose 3.0 acres from the water right when this transfer is certificated?

Also, I recommend that the use, described on certificate 33836, being only allowed if the Coast Fork flow at the mouth is 135 CFS or more and the Row River flow at mouth is 100 CFS or more: be a condition through the transfer process and ultimately on the final Certificate.





In reference to Water Right Transfer Application 7706, request for a description of the system used for delivery of irrigation water under the entire water right prior to the division of the property, we submit the following:

Water from Diversion point #1 was drawn using a 30hp 3 phase Cornell Model 4WB30-2 centrifugal pump with a capacity of an approximate 500gpm at 70psi. This fed a six inch aluminum hook and latch mainline, reducing to five and then to four inch depending on the set, and terminating with three inch aluminum hook and latch laterals utilizing approximately 24 Rainbird heads per set with 11/64 inch nozzles. Pressure at the lateral location was measured at 35 to 40 psi. Total lift for the system is about 7 feet.

Water from Diversion point #2 was drawn using a 15hp 3 phase Cornell Model 2 1/2W15-2 centrifugal pump with a capacity of an approximate 270gpm at 55 psi. This fed a five inch aluminum hook and latch mainline, reducing to four inch depending on the set, and terminating with three inch aluminum hook and latch laterals utilizing an approximately 24 Rainbird heads per set with 11/64 inch nozzles. Pressure readings at these laterals were 40 to 45 psi. Total lift for the system is is about 6 feet.

We trust this information will satisfy the requirements of the department.

I am reviewing your water right transfer application for a change in point of diversion. When I initially examined your application and map, I calculated the total revised acres against the total authorized acres and found that there are less total revised acres than the total authorized acres.

From our phone conversation on Friday, Jan. 9, I understand that there is really no change to the authorized acres involved in the transfer. This indicates to me that the cause of the difference in acres is due to use of different base maps and planimetering equipment by Mr. Hendricks, your Certified Water Rights Examiner, than what was used in the original final proof survey for the certificate. Any decrease in the acreage under the water right would result in a decrease in the quantity of water to be used by the right.

I am sending the transfer application map back to Mr. Hendricks so that he can amend it to reflect the authorized acres for Parcels 1 and 2. When he does this, he will also need to amend Part 2.(E) (the location and number of acres of that portion of the water right that will be affected by the change in point of diversion) of your transfer application. When that is finished, I will need a written statement from you telling me to amend Part 2 (E) of your transfer application.

Also, in order to bring your application to completion, I will need the following items completed and sent to me:

 A land use form for your local land use planning department to complete. If you have already submitted this form to your land use department, then you should contact them and find out if they have processed it. This form has to be filled out by them and sent to us in order for your transfer application to be complete. - A signed statement stating the water right has been used in the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the certificate.

Please send the completed Land Use form, statement of use, the amended Part 2.(E) of the application and amendment statement to me, Kelly Starnes, within sixty days. When I receive all of the requested items, I will mail you a publication notice that needs to be published in your local paper. If you have any questions, please call me at (800)-624-3199, ext. 309.

In March of this year (1997) we submitted an application for change of point of diversion and for revision of usage area due to the sale and division of property, effected by water right. Permit # 27756, Certificate # 33836. We received the receipt for our application fee with a letter of explanation stating that due to a backlog it may be up to two years before this is processed. At the time this appeared to be an acceptable situation but experience this past irrigation season has proven to be a problem for us due to the one point of diversion having too little flow to prevent excessive buildup of vegetation, causing chronic and expensive system problems. The other point of diversion is no longer on the subject property and although arrangements are in place to access the second point there are costly delays and issues of timing for irrigation that occur during the very hot and critical watering periods. 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




