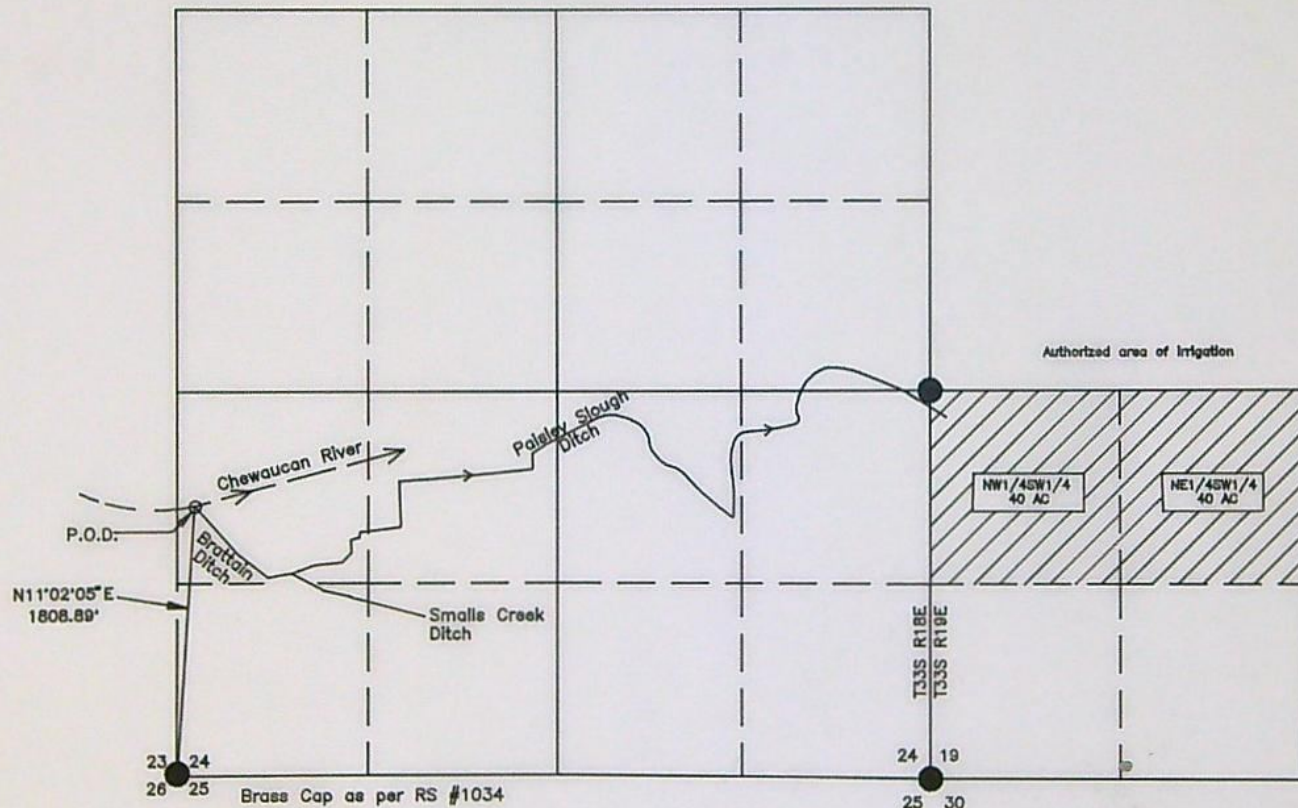

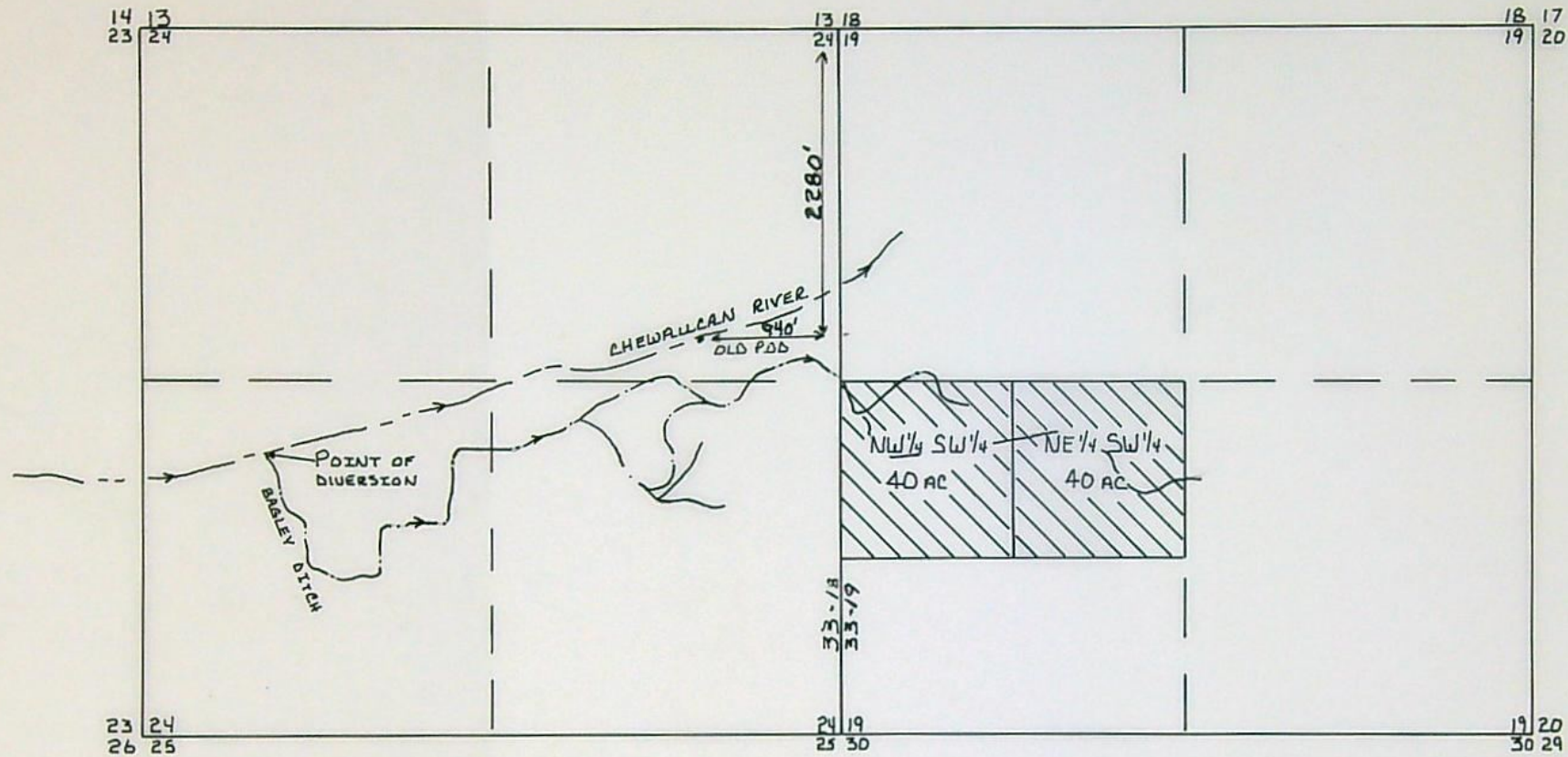
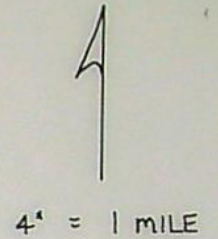

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That NORTHWEST TOWNSITE COMPANY, a corporation of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania 19118 has a right to the use of the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake for the purpose of the irrigation of 263 1/2 acres of land, and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1881 as to lands under proof No. 129, 1885 as to lands under proof No. 130, 1886 as to lands under proof No. 131 and June 18, 1896 as to lands under proof No. 132

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth in connection with each tract described below; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(Proof No. 129 for the irrigation of 17 acres) 12 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-three and 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-three South, Range Eighteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

I am writing to request that the Water Right Certificate for Water Right Transfer 6801 (T-6801) be issued immediately.

The special circumstances for this request are as follows:

- The Town Weir in the City of Paisley is in imminent structural failure. T-6801 approved on May 5, 1996 relocated the POD to the Town Weir.
- There is a project underway sponsored by the Bagley Ditch Corp to relocate the Town Weir approximately 3/4 of a mile upstream on the Chewaucan River. Engineering is complete. The construction involves using an infiltration gallery type diversion structure, improving fish passage, fish screen installation and stream channel restoration on the Chewaucan River through the City of Paisley.
- There are approximately 66 individual water right certificates that need to move their POD's that involve more than 110 individuals/families.
- The Water right Certificate for T-6801 needs to be issued so that it can be transferred with the Bagley Ditch Corp transfer application under preparation.
- The transfer application is scheduled to be submitted to OWRD in early March 2004.

I would like to participate in the Bagley Ditch Corp POD transfer process. I am concerned that if I do not have a Water Right Certificate for T-6801 and I participate in the Bagley Ditch Corp POD transfer, I could postpone the issuance of order approving a transfer application submitted by the Bagley Ditch Corp.

Item 1-B indicates that Certificate #3677 will be transferred. My records indicate that only a portion of this Certificate will be transferred. Proof #130 describes that portion affected by this transfer application. The application should be amended to read Certificate #3677, Proof #130.

Item 1-D indicates a date of priority of 1881. My records show a priority date of 1885 for Proof #130. The application should be so amended.

Item 2-B does not list the original Point of Diversion (POD). That original POD should be scaled from the proof map. I have enclosed a map sufficient to make this calculation. Please amend your application map to show original POD and Proposed POD.

Item 2-C indicates the original ditch used was the Bagley ditch. Proof #130 shows that the Lower Conn ditch was used to convey the water. The application should be so amended.



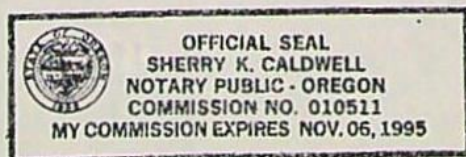



WaterWatch has reviewed the limited amount of information contained in the public notice of this transfer application. Based upon that information, WaterWatch raises the following issues, questions and concerns:

What effect will this proposed transfer have on instream flows necessary to protect the public's interest in fish, wildlife, recreation and a healthy aquatic system? Will this proposed transfer cause injury to any instream water right?

If this water source provides habitat for native fish during any phase of their life cycle, we request that the Department include conditions requiring the installation and maintenance of fish screening and bypass devices prior to any diversion of water resulting from this transfer.

Does the certificate to be transferred require measurement and recording of water use? Given the Department's limited enforcement capabilities, it only makes sense to require this applicant to measure and record water use. Measurement not only helps the Department carry out its statutory mandate to promote the control of water resources in Oregon for all beneficial purposes, it helps the Department protect the public's interest in assuring the use is within the bounds of the permit. ORS 536.220(1)(a), 537.170(5).

Will this proposed transfer be compatible with Goal 5 elements of the local comprehensive plan?

It is a high priority of the state to eliminate waste and improve the efficiency of water use. OAR 690-410-060(1). Statewide policy also calls upon water users to use and maintain their water systems in a manner consistent with the state's priority. OAR 690-410-060(a). What conditions are proposed for this transfer that will carry out and encourage compliance with state policy?
