I have received the attached copy of the current deed, thank you. When I received the revisions, I didn't realize that another water right, being Certificate 654, was added. Moving forward, there are a few issues that need to be resolved:

- Certificate 654 is a cancelled water right, so it is not subject to transfer;
- The application was received after July 1, 2021, which is when new fees took affect (Base Fee = \$950.00, 2 water rights involved=\$310.00, and 8.0 acres x \$2.70 = \$21.60). By my calculations, the applicant would actually owe the Department \$1,281.60, which is \$462.40 more than they originally paid; and
- If there is more than one water right involved, each water right must be identified on its own Table 2 (can't combine into 1 table).

These deficiencies would need to be corrected, most importantly the correct fee amount be paid, before I can proceed with this application. Please let me know if you need to discuss further.

I have completed my review of Temporary Transfer Application T-13763, and everything looks good but I need to verify one item. Table 2 "FROM" lands identifies 2.5 acres in NE NW, and 1.5 acres in NW NW of Section 1, T15S, 17E, WM, and the "TO" lands identifies 4.0 acres in SE SW of Section 36, T14S, R17E, WM. However the map shows the opposite, being 4.0 acres in SE SW of Section 36 coming "OFF", and 2.5 acres in NE NW, and 1.5 acres in NW NW of Section 1 coming "ON". Also, Certificate 550 does not authorize irrigation originating in Section 1, T15S, 17E, WM.

It appears that the "FROM" and "TO" lands in Table 2 are switched. I believe the application should indicate the 4.0 acres in Section 36 are the "FROM" lands, and 2.5 acres in NE NW, and 1.5 acres in NW NW of Section 1 are the "TO" lands. 



By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not *temporarily* use water at the new place of use or from the new point of diversion/appropriation until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands <u>from</u> which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land <u>to</u> which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.

If the land is sold before the temporary transfer is approved, the buyer's consent to the temporary transfer will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not *temporarily* use water at the new place of use or from the new point of diversion/appropriation until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands <u>from</u> which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land <u>to</u> which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.

If the land is sold before the temporary transfer is approved, the buyer's consent to the temporary transfer will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.


