Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 536.750 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the use, place of use or point of diversion of water in the event of a declaration of drought, without complying with the notice and waiting requirements under ORS 540.520. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 019 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating drought transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On July 26, 2021, OREGON LEASE KING, LLC filed an application to temporarily change the place of use under Certificate 72460 for the remainder of the 2021 irrigation season or the term of the Governor's declared drought, whichever is shorter. The Department assigned the application number T-13776.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 3, 2021, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On August 5, 2021, the Department contacted the applicant by written correspondence to notify the applicant of a deficiency in the application. The Table 2 "FROM" lands identified 13.8 acres, however, the "TO" lands identified 14.8 acres.
4. On August 9, 2021, the applicant submitted a revised Table 2.
5. On August 11, 2021, the Department contacted the applicant by written correspondence to notify the applicant of additional deficiencies in the application. The "TO" lands in the

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

revised Table 2 did not match the locations as identified on the application map. The application did not include an Evidence of Use Affidavit with supporting documentation, as is required under OAR 690-380-3000(12). The Department requested that the deficiencies be resolved by September 10, 2021. The Department did not receive a response to the additional deficiencies.

6. On September 10, 2021, upon further review of the revised Table 2, the applicant was requesting to change the place of use of 14.0 acres in the NE SE of Section 7, T30S, R4W, WM. Certificate 72460 authorizes only 13.0 acres in the NE SE of Section 7, T30S, R4W, WM.

7. The portion of the right to be temporarily transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 72460 in the name of WILLIS E. CAMPBELL (perfected under Permit S-7798)

Use: IRRIGATION of 13.8 ACRES

Priority Date: FEBRUARY 21, 1927

Rate: 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.18 CFS FROM THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER FOR IRRIGATION

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Temporary Drought Transfer Review Criteria

9. The Department is unable to determine if water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. Evidence that would demonstrate that the right is not subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610 was not submitted with the application, pursuant to OAR 690-380-3000(12).
10. The application did not include a description of the water delivery system. Therefore, the Department is unable to determine if a pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
11. The acres proposed for changing place of use (POU) do not match. The applicant is proposing to change the POU of more acres in the NE SE of Section 7, T30S, R4W, WM than is authorized by Certificate 72460, and the "TO" lands in the revised Table 2 do not match what is identified on the map.
12. The Governor issued an executive order on May 10, 2021, declaring a state of drought emergency in Douglas County due to drought and extreme weather conditions, which is still in effect and the water right proposed for transfer is on lands included in the area covered by the drought order.
13. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
14. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water right. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under OAR 690-019-055(3) if injury to existing water rights is shown and cannot be mitigated to the satisfaction of the Director and injured parties.


Conclusions of Law

The temporary change in place of use proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13776 is **NOT** consistent with the requirements of ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0055.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Transfer Application T-13776 is denied for failure to meet the requirements under ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0055.
