Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

1. On August 30, 2021, BERT AND TERRI SIDDOWAY filed an application for an additional point of appropriation under Permit G-17588. The Department assigned the application number T-13813.
2. On August 14, 2015, the Department approved an extension of time for complete application of water to October 1, 2021.
3. On January 6, 2023, the Department approved a second extension of time for complete application of water to October 1, 2026.
4. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on September 21, 2021, and in the Baker City Herald newspaper on May 2 and 9, 2023, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5).
5. Permit Amendment Application T-13813 proposes an additional point of appropriation approximately 0.50 mile from the existing points of appropriation to:

11 S	43 E	WM	18	SE SE	1869 FEET NORTH AND 732 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 18

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

6. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
7. The change does not enlarge the permit.
8. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.


Conclusions of Law

The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13813 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13813 is approved.
2. Permit G-18855, in the name of BERT AND TERRI SIDDOWAY, is issued to replace Permit G-17588, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, the extensions of time. Permit G-17588, in the name of BERT AND TERRI SIDDOWAY, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
4. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
6. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18855 remain the same.



PERMIT AMENDMENT T-12219 CONDITIONS

1. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
2. Prior to water use from the proposed points of appropriation, the permittee shall install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of appropriation. The permittee shall maintain the meter(s) or measuring device(s) in good working order.

The permittee shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter(s) or measuring device(s); provided however, where any meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.



The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring and reporting procedures for review and approval.

3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

EXTENSION CONDITIONS

The permit holder must submit a completed Progress Report Form to the Department by **October 1, 2020.**

- a. At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;
- b. The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

EXISTING CONDITIONS

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of appropriation. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- C. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where any meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- D. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring and reporting procedures for review and approval.

Prior to using water from any well listed on this permit, the permittee shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID tag), which shall be permanently attached to the well. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

The Department requires the water user to obtain, from a qualified individual (see below), and report annual static water levels for each well on the permit. The static water level shall be measured in the month of March. Reports shall be submitted to the Department within 30 days of measurement.

The permittee shall report an initial March static water-level measurement once well construction is complete and annual measurements thereafter. Annual measurements are required whether or not the well is used. The first annual measurement will establish a reference level against which future measurements will be compared. However, the Director may establish the reference level based on an analysis of other water-level data. The Director may require the user to obtain and report additional water levels each year if more data are needed to evaluate the aquifer system.

All measurements shall be made by a certified water rights examiner, registered professional geologist, registered professional engineer, licensed well constructor or pump installer licensed by the Construction Contractors Board. Measurements shall be submitted on forms provided by, or specified by, the Department. Measurements shall be made with equipment that is accurate to at least the standards specified in OAR 690-217-0045. The Department requires the individual performing the measurement to:

- A. Associate each measurement with an owner's well name or number and a Department well log ID; and
- B. Report water levels to at least the nearest tenth of a foot as depth-to-water below ground surface; and
- C. Specify the method of measurement; and
- D. Certify the accuracy of all measurements and calculations reported to the Department.

The water user shall discontinue use of, or reduce the rate or volume of withdrawal from, the well(s) if any of the following events occur:

- A. Annual water-level measurements reveal an average water-level decline of three or more feet per year for five consecutive years; or
- B. Annual water-level measurements reveal a water-level decline of 15 or more feet in fewer than five consecutive years; or

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- C. Annual water-level measurements reveal a water-level decline of 25 or more feet;
- D. Hydraulic interference leads to a decline of 25 or more feet in any neighboring well with senior priority.

The period of restricted use shall continue until the water level rises above the decline level which triggered the action or the Department determines, based on the permittee's and/or the Department's data and analysis, that no action is necessary because the aquifer in question can sustain the observed declines without adversely impacting the resource or causing substantial interference with senior water rights. The water user shall not allow excessive decline, as defined in Commission rules, to occur within the aquifer as a result of use under this permit. If more than one well is involved, the water user may submit an alternative measurement and reporting plan for review and approval by the Department.

The well(s) shall be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a minimum depth of 150.0 feet below land surface. If during well construction, it becomes apparent that the well can be constructed to eliminate interference with nearby shallow wells or hydraulically connected streams in a manner other than specified in this permit, the permittee can contact the Department Hydrogeologist for this permit or the Ground Water/Hydrology Section Manager to request approval of such construction. The request shall be in writing, and shall include a rough well log and a proposed construction design for approval by the Department. The request can be approved only if it is received and reviewed prior to placement of any permanent casing and sealing material. If the well is constructed first and then the request made, the requested modification will not be approved. If approved, the new well depth and construction specifications will be incorporated into any certificate issued for this permit.

At the time of perfection, the permittee may request that the use be certificated as primary irrigation, if water has been used beneficially according to the terms and conditions of this permit, and if underlying primary water rights are simultaneously diminished or canceled.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

If the number, location, source, or construction of any well deviates from that proposed in the permit application or required by permit conditions, this permit may be subject to cancellation, unless the Department authorizes the change in writing.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

The well(s) shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of appropriation, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area in accordance with ODFW's Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Policy OAR 635-415. For purposes of mitigation, the ODFW Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Goals and Standards, OAR 635-415, shall be followed.

The use may be restricted if the quality of downstream waters decreases to the point that those waters no longer meet existing state or federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.

Where two or more water users agree among themselves as to the manner of rotation in the use of water and such agreement is placed in writing and filed by such water users with the watermaster, and such rotation system does not infringe upon such prior rights of any water user not a party to such rotation plan, the watermaster shall distribute the water according to such agreement.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit to the Water Resources Department the results of a pump test meeting the Department's standards for each point of appropriation (well), unless an exemption has been obtained in writing under OAR 690-217. The Director may require water-level or pump-test data every ten years thereafter.


This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The original permit was issued September 9, 2010. Completion of construction and application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2021. If beneficial use of permitted water has not been made before this date, the permittee may submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.

Within one year after making beneficial use of water, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner.

Application History

Permit G-16783 was issued by the Department on September 9, 2010. The permit called for completion of construction by September 9, 2015 and complete application of water to beneficial use by September 9, 2015. On May 14, 2015, Bert and Terri Siddoway submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-16783. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on June 23, 2015, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction to October 1, 2021, and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2021. The protest period closed August 7, 2015, in



accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order dated June 23, 2015.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, any comments received, and information within the file, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. Checkpoint Condition

The permit holder must submit a completed Progress Report Form to the Department by **October 1, 2020**. *A form is enclosed with this Final Order.*

- (a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;
- (b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

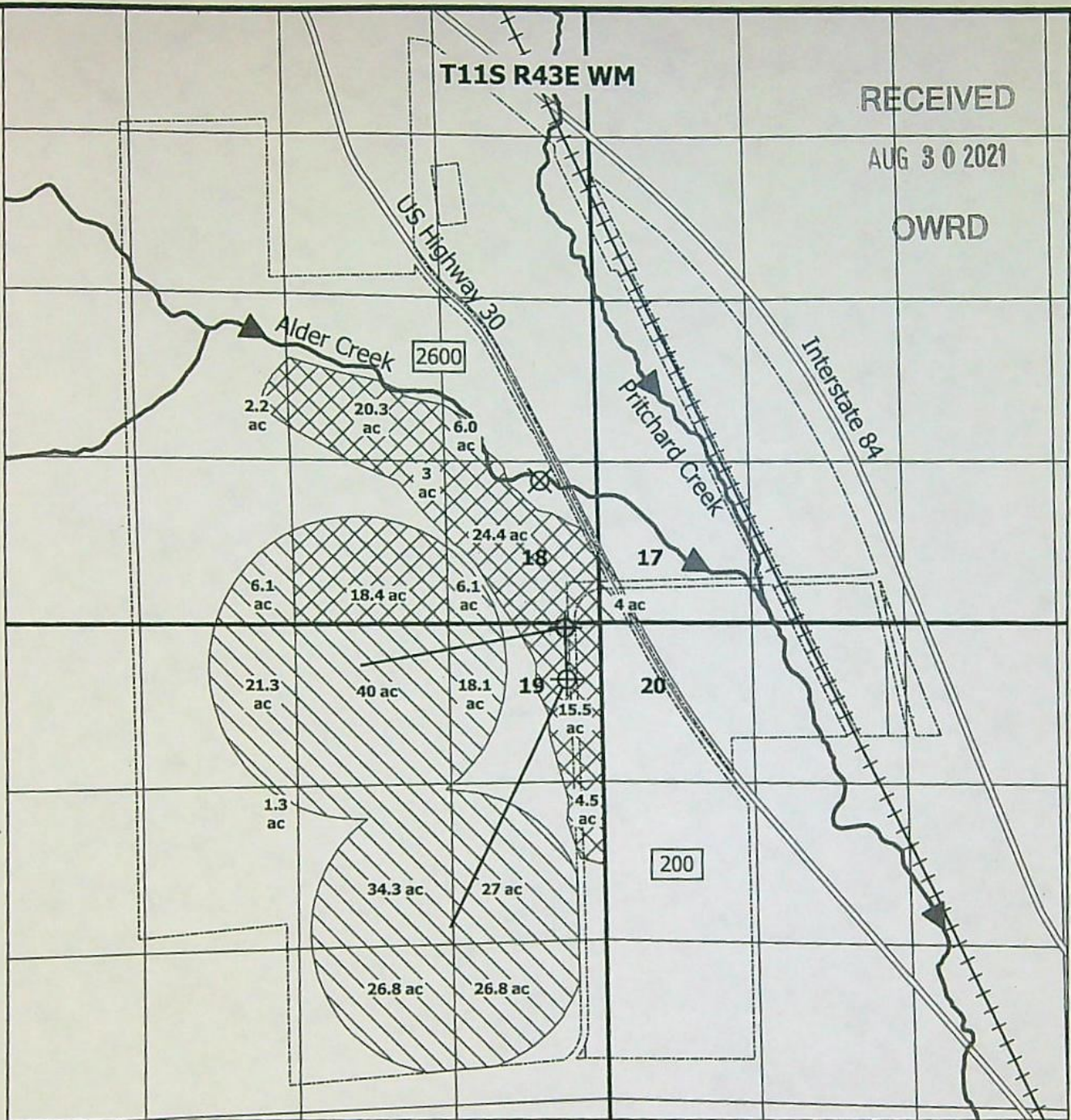

Findings of Fact

1. On December 21, 2015, BERT AND TERRI SIDDOWAY filed an application to change the point of appropriation and for an additional point of appropriation under Permit G-16783. The Department assigned the application number T-12219.
2. On August 14, 2015, the Department approved an extension of time for complete application of water to October 1, 2021.
3. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on December 29, 2015, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notice.
4. On March 18, 2016, the Department contacted the applicant's agent by telephone and email to resolve deficiencies in the application. The deficiencies being clarification of the type of change requested, the authorized point of appropriation was missing from the map and there was a small portion of the map that is incorrectly hatchured for the type of use.
5. On March 23, 2016, the agent submitted an amended application page and map resolving the issues. As part of the resolution, it was determined that this is just a point of appropriation change, not an additional point of appropriation change.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

6. Permit Amendment Application T-12219 proposes to move the authorized point of appropriation approximately 544 feet and 115 feet respectively, from the existing point of appropriation to:

7. Permit G-16783 included a condition "The well(s) shall be continuously cased and continuously sealed to a minimum depth of 150.0 feet below land surface. If during well construction, it becomes apparent that the well can be constructed to eliminate interference with nearby shallow wells or hydraulically connected streams in a manner other than specified in this permit, the permittee can contact the Department Hydrogeologist for this permit or the Ground Water/Hydrology Section Manager to request approval of such construction. The request shall be in writing, and shall include a rough well log and a proposed construction design for approval by the Department. The request can be approved only if it is received and reviewed prior to placement of any permanent casing and sealing material. If the well is constructed first and then the request made, the requested modification will not be approved. If approved, the new well depth and construction specifications will be incorporated into any certificate issued for this permit." On January 4, 2012, Department Ground Water Staff approved a seal depth of 26 feet for the well. The new wells were reviewed and approved for this transfer based on the January 4, 2012, approval.

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

8. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
9. The change does not enlarge the permit.
10. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12219 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12219 is approved.
2. Permit G-17588, in the name of BERT AND TERRI SIDDOWAY, is issued to replace Permit G-16783, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order and the extension of time. Permit G-16783, in the name of BERT AND TERRI SIDDOWAY, is no longer of any force or effect.

Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the **Transfer Application**. (**Application Number: T-13813**)

1. **Authority.** The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
2. **Restrictions.** Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
3. **Effective Date and Duration.** Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.
4. **Consideration.**
 - a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is **\$1,069.14**. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of **\$1,069.14** to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.
 - b. The costs stated in this Agreement do not include the statutory application processing and filing fees.
5. **Confidentiality.** Applicant agrees that any information provided to or acquired by OWRD under this Agreement will be subject to the Oregon Public Records Law and shall be considered public records.

The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

7. **Termination.** Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
8. **Funds Authorized and Available.** By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
9. **Duration of Estimate.** The Estimate of Time to completion is **approximately** 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
10. **Completion Date.** OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information. **IMPORTANT:** Due to COVID-19 and actions taken by the State of Oregon to facilitate teleworking as a tool to help prevent the spread of the disease, Department processes for Reimbursement Authority may be unavoidably delayed.
11. **Captions.** The captions or headings in this Agreement are for the convenience only and in no way define, limit, or describe the scope, or intent, of any provision of this Agreement.
12. **Amendment and Merger.** The terms of this Agreement shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented, or amended in any manner whatsoever, except by written instrument signed by both parties. Such waiver, consent, modification or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. There are no understandings, agreements or representations, oral or written, not specified herein regarding this Agreement.
13. **Signatures.** All parties, by the authorized representative's signature below, hereby acknowledge that they have read this Agreement, understand it and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.


