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In the Matter of Transfer Application T-13790, Grant County FINAL ORDER APPROVING AN EMERGENCY USE DROUGHT TEMPORARY CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE

## Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 536.750 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the use, place of use or point of diversion of water in the event of a declaration of drought, without complying with the notice and waiting requirements under ORS 540.520. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 019 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating drought transfer applications.

### Applicant

CITY OF PRAIRIE CITY 133 SOUTH BRIDGE STREET PRAIRIE CITY, OR 97869

### **Findings of Fact**

- On August 10, 2021, CITY OF PRAIRIE CITY filed an application to temporarily change the character of use and change the place of use under Certificate 82329 for the remainder of the 2021 irrigation season or the term of the Governor's declared drought, whichever is shorter. The Department assigned the application number T-13790.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 24, 2021, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On August 25, 2021, the Department contacted the applicant by written correspondence to notify the applicant and the applicant's agent of a deficiency in the application. The application did not include an Evidence of Use Affidavit and supporting documentation, as is required by OAR 690-380-3000(12). The Department requested that the deficiencies be resolved by September 27, 2021.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On September 10, 2021, the applicant submitted an Evidence of Use Affidavit and supporting documentation, resolving the deficiency.
- 5. The right to be temporarily transferred is as follows:

 Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13790 proposes to change the character of use to Municipal Uses.

#### Temporary Drought Transfer Review Criteria

- Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 9. A pump and water distribution system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
- 10. The Governor issued an executive order on June 29, 2021, declaring a state of drought emergency in Grant County due to drought and extreme weather conditions, which is still in effect and the water right proposed for transfer is on lands included in the area covered by the drought order.
- 11. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 12. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under OAR 690-019-055(3) if injury to existing water rights is shown and cannot be mitigated to the satisfaction of the Director and injured parties.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

The temporary change in character of use and place of use proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13790 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0055.

#### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The temporary change in character of use and place of use proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13790 is approved.
- The former places of use shall not receive water as part of this water right during the remainder of 2021 or until the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.

- 3. The approval of this temporary drought transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- 4. The use of water at the temporary places of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 82329. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2021 season or the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first..
- 5. The proposed change in character of use and place of use shall revert to the authorized character of use and place of use at the end of the 2021 irrigation season or the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.

The City of Prairie City began using Prairie Wood Products well (named in this transfer application) earlier in the summer of 2021 (I do not have an exact date as the city did not inform me of their intentions or actions - I found out from the Office of Emergency Management and found this well being used 7/29/21). I believe there may be hydraulic connection to the John Day River from this well. I defer to the ground water section for their determination if this is actually occurring. I have experienced difficulty with stable river flows that follow a traditional decline curve all summer long which caused extreme difficulty managing the available resources of the John Day River. No other anomalies of water use were noted all summer long, except the use of this well by the City of Prairie City.

# Prairie Wood mill shutting down

PRAIRIE CITY - The Prairie Wood Products sawmill is shutting down in the face of continued housing market woes and diminished timber supplies.

The company is terming the current closure as temporary.

The mill is laying off about 45 workers, according to Don Bodewig, Eastern Oregon regional manager for DR Johnson Lumber, Prairie Wood's parent company.

Bodewig called the layoffs regrettable but indicated they are linked to challenging times facing the industry as a whole. He cited the continuing downturn in the lumber markets and the lack of available timber as major factors. The major economic downturn for the nation also has had an impact, he said.

The schedule called for the Prairie Wood sawmill to stop work Tuesday, Sept. 30, while the planer mill will shut down Friday, Oct. 3.

Bodewig said the company plans to continue building its log inventory in the yard at Prairie City, in hopes of a rebound in the marketplace. The goal is to maintain a position to be competitive if and when the economy and supply improve. The shutdown leaves DR Johnson, which owns five sawmills, with two mills in operation: Umpqua Lumber Co. and DR Johnson in Riddle, both in Southern Oregon. The Wallowa Forest Products mill in Wallowa and Grant Western Lumber Co. in John Day remain closed from an earlier closure.

"We will continue to monitor the market conditions on a daily basis," said Randy Crockett, chief operations officer for DR Johnson.

Upon completion of an initial review of Drought Temporary Transfer T-13790, it was determined that one deficiency needs to be resolved before the Department can proceed with the application. The application did not include an Evidence of Use Affidavit (attached), along with the supporting documentation. Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule 690-380-3000(12), each transfer application shall include evidence that the water has been used over the past five years in accordance with the terms and conditions of the right or that the right is not subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610. The evidence shall include the following information:

(a) If the right has been used during the past five years, one or more affidavits from persons, such as the owner or operator, a neighbor, crop field person for a cannery or other product buyer, or Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) representatives, who can attest from personal knowledge or professional expertise that the right was exercised at the authorized location and for the authorized purpose. Such affidavits shall state the specific grounds for the affiant's knowledge, the specific use to which the water was put (e.g., the crops grown, the nursery stock watered), and the delivery system used to apply the water and include supporting documentation such as:

(A) Copies of receipts from sales of irrigated crops or for expenditures relating to use of water;

(B) Records such as Farm Service Agency crop reports, irrigation district records, an NRCS farm management plan, or records of other water suppliers; or

(C) Dated aerial photographs of the lands or other photographs containing sufficient detail to establish the location and date of the photograph, or

(b) If the right has not been used during the past five years, documentation that the presumption of forfeiture would be rebutted under ORS 540.610(2).

Please submit the attached Evidence of Use Affidavit and supporting documentation no later than September 27, 2021. If the Department does not receive the above requested materials by September 27, 2021, a Final Order may be issued denying the application as incomplete.
