Ochoco Irrigation District (OID) would like to submit the following comments for Transfer T-13793.

The application proposes several areas of concern for OID.

OID has senior water rights on both Ochoco and McKay Creeks. (C-82246 and C-82249). Our District also owns and operates Ochoco Reservoir. OID'S position is that water rights above our project may not be transferred below our project.

On McKay Creek alone the proposed transfer C-42373 with a priority date of 1964 would not make it past OID'S 6 diversions with McKay Creek Water Rights senior (C-82246 and C-82249) to the proposed. There is the question of moving the water rights so far down the Crooked River, that this junior McKay Creek only water right would become convoluted with Ochoco Creek water, Crooked River water, project return flows both from OID and Central Oregon Irrigation (COI), and Deschutes water as the proposed point of use is below the North Unit pumps. The change of use is also proposed for a nursery? Using a 1964 McKay Creek water right for a nursery? The on map indicates this use will be under a pivot and already covered with a COI District Right. On Ochoco Creek, OID recognizes the validity of an 1880 water right (C-89615). This right does not appear to be transferred in whole as it proposes to transfer 9.8 acres out of the 14.8 acres water rights with a diversion rate of 0.19 CFS. This means only 66% or 0.12 would be the diversion rate downstream.

OID holds senior water rights on Ochoco Creek below the dam (C-82249). As stated previously, OID opposes water rights above our project being transferred below.

There are also large senior rights (1870) on Ochoco Creek above Ochoco Reservoir in the same reach as the proposed transfer. The likelihood of this small amount of water surviving these senior rights and measurability in the system seems nil.

As stated on the McKay Creek rights, there is a question of moving these rights (Ochoco) far down in the system, below the North Unit pumps. This move of 0.12 CFS seems unmanageable when Ochoco Creek goes dry and needs to be regulated off. If this transfer were approved, it appears unmanageable when this small amount of water is comingled with OID project water, Crooked River water, return flows from OID and COI, and Deschutes water below the North Unit pumps on the Crooked River

OID appreciates the opportunity to comment on this application.

To Whom It May Concern:

Central Oregon Irrigation District (COID) would like to submit comment on T-13793.

COID holds two certificates, C-94956, a 1900 primary Deschutes live-flow right, and C-76714, a 1913 supplemental right to use storage from Crane Prairie Reservoir. Both certificates have irrigation water rights appurtenant to the proposed lands in T-13793. The T-13793 applicant did not inform COID of the proposed transfer, nor did they provide COID the required supplemental form D.

The proposed transfer application map places water onto lands fully irrigated by the appurtenant COID water rights. We understand the type of use of the proposed water right will be changed to a nursery right, preventing it from layering onto the COID rights. Without having had any communication from the applicant as to the intended use of the new "nursery" right, COID is concerned as to how and when the proposed water will be used.

The proposed transferring water rights have 1880 (C-89615) and 1964 (C-42373) priority dates, one being much junior to the COID rights. It is our understanding there are 1870 Ochoco Creek rights above Ochoco Reservoir. The availability and reliability of the proposed water at the proposed POD on the Crooked River is questionable.

Should OWRD decide to approve T-13793, COID requests conditions be placed on the transfer, limiting any irrigation under the nursery right to the months of November through March and prohibiting co-mingling with COID water rights.



OID has senior water rights on both Ochoco and McKay Creeks. (C-82246 and C-82249). Our District also owns and operates Ochoco Reservoir. OID'S position is that water rights above our project may not be transferred below our project.

On McKay Creek alone the proposed transfer C-42373 with a priority date of 1964 would not make it past OID'S 6 diversions with McKay Creek Water Rights senior (C-82246 and C-82249) to the proposed. There is the question of moving the water rights so far down the Crooked River, that this junior McKay Creek only water right would become convoluted with Ochoco Creek water, Crooked River water, project return flows both from OID and Central Oregon Irrigation (COI), and Deschutes water as the proposed point of use is below the North Unit pumps. The change of use is also proposed for a nursery? Using a 1964 McKay Creek water right for a nursery? The on map indicates this use will be under a pivot and already covered with a COI District Right. On Ochoco Creek, OID recognizes the validity of an 1880 water right (C-89615). This right does not appear to be transferred in whole as it proposes to transfer 9.8 acres out of the 14.8 acres water rights with a diversion rate of 0.19 CFS. This means only 66% or 0.12 would be the diversion rate downstream.

OID holds senior water rights on Ochoco Creek below the dam (C-82249). As stated previously, OID opposes water rights above our project being transferred below. There are also large senior rights (1870) on Ochoco Creek above Ochoco Reservoir in the same reach as the proposed transfer. The likelihood of this small amount of water surviving these senior rights and measurability in the system seems nil.



As stated on the McKay Creek rights, there is a question of moving these rights (Ochoco) far down in the system, below the North Unit pumps. This move of 0.12 CFS seems unmanageable when Ochoco Creek goes dry and needs to be regulated off. If this transfer were approved, it appears unmanageable when this small amount of water is comingled with OID project water, Crooked River water, return flows from OID and COI, and Deschutes water below the North Unit pumps on the Crooked River

OID appreciates the opportunity to comment on this application.

To Whom It May Concern:

Central Oregon Irrigation District (COID) would like to submit comment on T-13793.

COID holds two certificates, C-94956, a 1900 primary Deschutes live-flow right, and C-76714, a 1913 supplemental right to use storage from Crane Prairie Reservoir. Both certificates have irrigation water rights appurtenant to the proposed lands in T-13793. The T-13793 applicant did not inform COID of the proposed transfer, nor did they provide COID the required supplemental form D.

The proposed transfer application map places water onto lands fully irrigated by the appurtenant COID water rights. We understand the type of use of the proposed water right will be changed to a nursery right, preventing it from layering onto the COID rights. Without having had any communication from the applicant as to the intended use of the new "nursery" right, COID is concerned as to how and when the proposed water will be used.

The proposed transferring water rights have 1880 (C-89615) and 1964 (C-42373) priority dates, one being much junior to the COID rights. It is our understanding there are 1870 Ochoco Creek rights above Ochoco Reservoir. The availability and reliability of the proposed water at the proposed POD on the Crooked River is questionable.

Should OWRD decide to approve T-13793, COID requests conditions be placed on the transfer, limiting any irrigation under the nursery right to the months of November through March and prohibiting co-mingling with COID water rights.







On August 13, 2021, OWRD received your water right Permanent Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$4560.00. Our receipt number 136153 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to determine if a fish screen is needed.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water for the new use, in the new place of use or from the new point of diversion until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.

If the land is sold before the application is approved, the buyer's consent to the application will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.



Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Transfer Application. (Application Number: T-13793)

- Authority. The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any
 applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In
 making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
- Restrictions. Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
- Effective Date and Duration. Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.

4. Consideration.

- a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$941.66. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$941.66 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.
- b. The costs stated in this Agreement do not include the statutory application processing and filing fees.
- Confidentiality. Applicant agrees that any information provided to or acquired by OWRD under this Agreement will be subject to the Oregon Public Records Law and shall be considered public records.
- 6. Indemnity. Applicant shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify the State of Oregon, OWRD, and their officers, employees, and agents from and against all claims, suits, actions, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses of any nature resulting from or arising out of, or relating to the activities of Applicant or its representatives, officers, employees, contractors, or agents under this Agreement or with respect to the expedited service. The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

- 7. Termination. Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
- Funds Authorized and Available. By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
- 9. Duration of Estimate. The Estimate of Time to completion is approximately 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
- 10. Completion Date. OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information.
 IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19 and actions taken by the State of Oregon to facilitate teleworking as a tool to help prevent the spread of the disease, Department processes for Reimbursement Authority may be unavoidably delayed.
