

As you know, our office represents Kameron DeLashmutt and Pinnacle Utilities, LLC (collectively, the "Applicant") in a request for a Land Use Information Form ("LUCS") for the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD"). This letter provides additional information regarding that request.

Applicant seeks to transfer the place of use and type of use of 50.00 acres of C-95746, to provide quasi-municipal water to the Thornburgh Destination Resort. Quasi-municipal water is defined under state rule.

To clarify any misunderstanding, a quasi-municipal water use is defined as is relevant at OAR 690-300-0010(40):

"Quasi-Municipal Water Use" means the delivery and use of water through the water service system of a corporation other than a public corporation created for the purpose of operating a water supply system, for those uses usual and ordinary to municipal water use, or a federally recognized Indian tribe that operates a water supply system for uses usual and ordinary to a municipal water use.

That definition refers to uses that are "usual and ordinary to municipal water use", which is defined at OAR 690-300-0010(29):

"Municipal Water Use" means the delivery and use of water through the water service system of a municipal corporation for all water uses usual and ordinary to such systems. Examples of these water uses shall include but are not limited to domestic water use, irrigation of lawns and gardens, commercial water use, industrial water use, fire protection, irrigation and other water uses in park and

recreation facilities, and street washing. Such uses shall not include generation of hydroelectric power.

Findings of Fact

- On October 22, 2021, KAMERON DELASHMUTT/PINNACLE UTILITIES LLC AND CENTRAL LAND AND CATTLE COMPANY, LLC, filed an application change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use under Certificate 95746. The Department assigned the application number T-13857.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on November 23, 2021, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. Five timely comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. The issues raised by the commenter do not address the criteria for review of a water right transfer as per OAR 690-380-4010 and approval of a transfer application under OAR 690-380-5000. The statutory basis for approving a water right transfer application is relatively narrow and confined to the department finding or determining:
 - a) The water right proposed for transfer is a water use subject to transfer;
 - b) The portion of the water right proposed for transfer is not cancelled due to forfeiture for non-use pursuant to ORS 540.610;

 The proposed transfer would not result in enlargement of the water right proposed for transfer; and

d) The proposed transfer would not result in injury to other water rights.

4. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2), OAR 690-380-2110(2), OAR 690-380-2130]

- 8. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the
 existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer
 Application T-13857.
- 10. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 11. The current point of diversion is located on the Little Deschutes River. The nearest surface water to the proposed groundwater points of appropriation is the Deschutes River downstream from the confluence of the Little Deschutes and Deschutes rivers. The distance along the river between the existing surface water point of diversion and the proposed groundwater points of appropriation is over 100 river miles. Pumping from the proposed groundwater points of appropriation will have no effect on the Little Deschutes River but instead will affect the Deschutes River downstream from the proposed groundwater points of appropriation and will also likely affect the Crooked River near the

- confluence with the Deschutes River. Previous studies have identified the Crooked River as a major discharge zone for the regional aquifer system that the proposed groundwater points of appropriation are producing from (Gannett et al., 2000; Gannett and Lite, 2003).
- 12. Surface water in the Crooked River is fully allocated and any new groundwater allocation within the Deschutes Groundwater Study Area, which includes the affected reach of the Crooked River, requires mitigation for impacts to surface water. Approval of this transfer would impact the Crooked River which is not being impacted by use from the current surface water point of diversion and so is considered a significant impact to the Crooked River.
- 13. OAR 690-380-2130(3) requires that SW-GW transfers in the Deschutes Groundwater Study Area only "affect the surface water source hydraulically connected to the authorized point of diversion specified in the water use subject to transfer". For this application, the surface water source hydraulically connected to the point of diversion is the Little Deschutes River whereas groundwater pumping at the proposed points of appropriation would affect the Deschutes River, Crooked River, and possibly smaller streams north of the proposed groundwater points of appropriation. Groundwater pumping at the proposed points of appropriation would not affect, the original surface water source of the Little Deschutes River.
- 14. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the right.
- The proposed changes in Transfer Application T-13857 would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 16. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13857 appear to be not consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580, OAR 690-380-2130, and 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be denied.

If the issues identified above are resolved, and Transfer Application T-13857 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- The change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13857 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 95746 and any related decree.

- 3. Water right Certificate 95746 is modified and will be cancelled upon approval or denial of T-13764 and T-13857. A new certificate will be used describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer, and T-13764, and T-13857.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (WELL 1, WELL 2, WELL 3, WELL 4, WELL 5, WELL 6, WELL 7, and WELL 8) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 5. The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.
- 6. If, within five years after approval of the transfer, the Department finds that the transfer results in substantial or undue interference with an existing ground water right due to use of the wells, that would not have occurred in the absence of the transfer, the new point of appropriation shall be subordinate to the existing right injured by the transfer.
- 7. The original point of diversion of surface water shall not be retained as an additional or supplemental point of diversion under the transferred portion of the right. However, if within five years after approval of the transfer, the Department receives a transfer application to return to the last authorized surface water point of diversion, the application shall be approved.
- 8. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each at each new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 10. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2024. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 11. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Please find enclosed a draft of our Preliminary Determination regarding Transfer Application T-13857. The document reflects the Department's conclusion that, based on the information currently available, the transfer will be DENIED. This draft is intended to provide you with an opportunity to comment on our findings and conclusions should you wish to do so and to withdraw or modify your application to resolve the issues that are prompting our decision to deny the application.

The draft Preliminary Determination proposes to deny the transfer application for the following reasons:

 The proposed change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation does not meet the requirements of OAR 690-380-2130(3)(d): the use of the new point of diversion will affect the surface water source hydraulically connected to the authorized point of diversion specified in the water use subject to transfer.

At this point, you may decide to continue processing the application (see below), or to send a letter requesting to withdraw the transfer application.

If you wish to proceed with your application, you must submit the following:

- Provide a written response by MONTH, DAY, YEAR, that describes how you will overcome
 the issues identified above and submit modifications or additional information as needed,
 or that indicates you wish to protest a Preliminary Determination to deny the transfer.
- REQUIRED: You must submit a Report of Ownership for the lands where the water right(s) are currently located (i.e., the FROM lands). This report:
 - a) Must be prepared by a title company;
 - Shall include a "prepared by" statement and the date the title company prepared the report printed on the cover sheet;
 - c) Must be:
 - i. Prepared within 3 months of the Draft Preliminary Determination showing current ownership; OR
 - ii. Prepared within 3 months of recording of a water right conveyance agreement; OR

iii. Have a prepared date showing ownership at the time a water right conveyance agreement was recorded.

If water right conveyance agreements are involved, it is helpful to provide copies of those agreements along with the Report of Ownership.

IMPORTANT: In order for the Department to clearly understand the date that the title company prepared the Report of Ownership, the title company must indicate/state the date that they prepared the report on the coversheet and/or first page of the report.

- d) Must include a list of owners at the time the report was generated; AND
- e) Must include a legal description of the property where the water right to be transferred is currently located (i.e., the FROM lands).
- You must provide a notarized statement of consent signed by any landowner listed in the Report of Ownership who is <u>not</u> already included in the transfer application. The Department's statement of consent form (Consent By Deeded Landowner) is available at: https://www.oregon.gov/OWRD/WRDFormsPDF/consent to transfer form.pdf
- 6. Notice of this transfer will need to be published in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water rights are currently located. You will be responsible for the charges.

What happens next...

Once the Preliminary Determination is issued a publication period is required. Because there is more than ¼ mile between the new and the authorized point of diversion and the proposed points of appropriation, the Department will publish notice of the transfer in a local newspaper having a general circulation in the area of the water right at least once per week for two consecutive weeks. You are responsible for sending a check to cover the cost of publication prior to the issuance of the Preliminary Determination and publication of notice (see below).

Conditions to your water right...

If you modify the application so as to allow approval, conditions may need to be added to the transfer. The Department will notify you of any required conditions prior to issuing the Preliminary Determination.

Issuance of the Preliminary Determination will occur shortly after we receive:

- 1. Your written response modifying the application to resolve the issues that we have identified or requesting that we proceed with processing of the application; and
- The Report of Ownership, including affidavits of consent from any landowners shown in the
 ownership report who have not signed the transfer application. The title company must
 indicate/state the date that they prepared the ownership report on the coversheet and/or first
 page of the report.

If we do not receive your response to withdraw the application or the items listed above by [insert 30 day due date here], a Preliminary Determination may be issued denying the application as incomplete.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2), OAR 690-380-2110(2), OAR 690-380-2130]

- 8. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the
 existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer
 Application T-13857.
- 10. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 11. The current point of diversion is located on the Little Deschutes River. The nearest surface water to the proposed groundwater points of appropriation is the Deschutes River downstream from the confluence of the Little Deschutes and Deschutes rivers. The distance along the river between the existing surface water point of diversion and the proposed groundwater points of appropriation is over 100 river miles. Pumping from the proposed groundwater points of appropriation will have no effect on the Little Deschutes River but instead will affect the Deschutes River downstream from the proposed groundwater points of appropriation and will also likely affect the Crooked River near the

- confluence with the Deschutes River. Previous studies have identified the Crooked River as a major discharge zone for the regional aquifer system that the proposed groundwater points of appropriation are producing from (Gannett et al., 2000; Gannett and Lite, 2003).
- 12. Surface water in the Crooked River is fully allocated and any new groundwater allocation within the Deschutes Groundwater Study Area, which includes the affected reach of the Crooked River, requires mitigation for impacts to surface water. Approval of this transfer would impact the Crooked River which is not being impacted by use from the current surface water point of diversion and so is considered a significant impact to the Crooked River.
- 13. OAR 690-380-2130(3) requires that SW-GW transfers in the Deschutes Groundwater Study Area only "affect the surface water source hydraulically connected to the authorized point of diversion specified in the water use subject to transfer". For this application, the surface water source hydraulically connected to the point of diversion is the Little Deschutes River whereas groundwater pumping at the proposed points of appropriation would affect the Deschutes River, Crooked River, and possibly smaller streams north of the proposed groundwater points of appropriation. Groundwater pumping at the proposed points of appropriation would not affect, the original surface water source of the Little Deschutes River.
- 14. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 15. The proposed changes in Transfer Application T-13857 would not result in injury to other water rights. Approval of this transfer would impact the Crooked River which is not being impacted by use from the current surface water point of diversion and so is considered a significant impact to the Crooked River weedspecify which water with the contract of the contr
- 16. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13857 appear to be not consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580, OAR 690-380-2110 (2), OAR 690-380-2130, and 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be denied.

If the issues identified above are resolved, and Transfer Application T-13857 is approved, the final order will include the following:

 The change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13857 are approved.

- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 95746 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificate 95746 is modified and will be cancelled upon approval or denial of T-13764 and T-13857. A new certificate will be used describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer, and T-13764, and T-13857.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (WELL 1, WELL 2, WELL 3, WELL 4, WELL 5, WELL 6, WELL 7, and WELL 8) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 5. The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.
- 6. If, within five years after approval of the transfer, the Department finds that the transfer results in substantial or undue interference with an existing ground water right due to use of the wells, that would not have occurred in the absence of the transfer, the new point of appropriation shall be subordinate to the existing right injured by the transfer.
- 7. The original point of diversion of surface water shall not be retained as an additional or supplemental point of diversion under the transferred portion of the right. However, if within five years after approval of the transfer, the Department receives a transfer application to return to the last authorized surface water point of diversion, the application shall be approved.
- 8. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each at each new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices;; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 10. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2024. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.

11. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

The distance along the river between the existing surface water point of diversion and the proposed groundwater points of appropriation is over 100 river miles. Pumping from the proposed groundwater points of appropriation will have no effect on the Little Deschutes River but instead will affect the Deschutes River downstream from the proposed groundwater points of appropriation and will also likely affect the Crooked River near the confluence with the Deschutes River. Previous studies have identified the Crooked River as a major discharge zone for the regional aquifer system that the proposed groundwater points of appropriation are producing from (Gannett et al., 2000; Gannett and Lite, 2003).
- 9. Surface water in the Crooked River is fully allocated and any new groundwater allocation within the Deschutes Groundwater Study Area, which includes the affected reach of the Crooked River, requires mitigation for impacts to surface water. Approval of this transfer would impact the Crooked River which is not being impacted by use from the current surface water point of diversion and so is considered a significant impact to the Crooked River.
- 10. OAR 690-380-2130(3) requires that SW-GW transfers in the Deschutes Groundwater Study Area only "affect the surface water source hydraulically connected to the authorized point

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of diversion specified in the water use subject to transfer". For this application, the surface water source hydraulically connected to the point of diversion is the Little Deschutes River whereas groundwater pumping at the proposed points of appropriation would affect the Deschutes River, Crooked River, and possibly smaller streams north of the proposed groundwater points of appropriation. Groundwater pumping at the proposed points of appropriation would not affect, in any reasonable sense, the original surface water source of the Little Deschutes River.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2), OAR 690-380-2110(2), OAR 690-380-2130]

- 11. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 12. A diversion structure and canal sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13857.
- 13. The proposed changes in Transfer Application T-13857 would result in enlargement. OAR 690-380-2110(2) Except as provided in ORS 540.531 and OAR 690-380-2130, a change in point of diversion is restricted to the same source of surface water. A change in point of appropriation under a water right or certificate of registration modification is restricted to the same aquifer.
- 14. The proposed changes in Transfer Application T-13857 would result in injury to other water rights. Approval of this transfer would impact the Crooked River which is not being impacted by use from the current surface water point of diversion and so is considered a significant impact to the Crooked River
- 15. The proposed changes in Transfer Application T-13857 does not meet the definition of similarly as per OAR 690-380-2130. Deschites Basin Sweet do not
- 16. All other application requirements are met.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13857 appear to not be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580, OAR 690-380-2110 (2), OAR 690-380-2130, and 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be denied.

If the issues described above are resolved

If the enlargement and injury is overcome, and Transfer Application T-13857 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- The change from a surface water point of diversion to a groundwater point of appropriation, place of use, and character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13857 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 95746 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificate 95746 is modified and will be cancelled upon approval or denial of T-13764 and T-13857. A new certificate will be used describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer, and T-13764, and T-13857.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (WELL 1, WELL 2, WELL 3, WELL 4, WELL 5, WELL 6, WELL 7, and WELL 8) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 5. The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.
- 6. If, within five years after approval of the transfer, the Department finds that the transfer results in substantial or undue interference with an existing ground water right due to use of the wells, that would not have occurred in the absence of the transfer, the new point of appropriation shall be subordinate to the existing right injured by the transfer.
- 7. The original point of diversion of surface water shall not be retained as an additional or supplemental point of diversion under the transferred portion of the right. However, if within five years after approval of the transfer, the Department receives a transfer application to return to the last authorized surface water point of diversion, the application shall be approved.
- 8. Water use measurement conditions: Hotias 122
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each at each new point of appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices;; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

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- 9. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 10. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2024**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 11. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

IMPORTANT: In order for the Department to clearly understand the date that the title company prepared the Report of Ownership, the title company must indicate/state the date that they prepared the report on the coversheet and/or first page of the report.

- You must provide a notarized statement of consent signed by any landowner listed in the Report of Ownership who is <u>not</u> already included in the transfer application. - 6. Notice of this transfer will need to be published in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water rights are currently located. You will be responsible for the charges.

What happens next...

Once the Preliminary Determination is issued a publication period is required. Because there is more than ¼ mile between the new and the authorized point of diversion and the proposed points of appropriation, the Department will publish notice of the transfer in a local newspaper having a general circulation in the area of the water right at least once per

week for two consecutive weeks. You are responsible for sending a check to cover the cost of publication prior to the issuance of the Preliminary Determination and publication of notice (see below).

Conditions to your water right...

If you modify the application so as to allow approval, conditions may need to be added to the transfer. The Department will notify you of any required conditions prior to issuing the Preliminary Determination.

Issuance of the Preliminary Determination will occur shortly after we receive:

- 1. Your written response modifying the application to resolve the issues that we have identified or requesting that we proceed with processing of the application; and
- The Report of Ownership, including affidavits of consent from any landowners shown in the
 ownership report who have not signed the transfer application. The title company must
 indicate/state the date that they prepared the ownership report on the coversheet and/or first
 page of the report.

If we do not receive your response to withdraw the application or the items listed above by [insert 30 day due date here], a Preliminary Determination may be issued denying the application as incomplete.





As you know, our office represents Kameron DeLashmutt and Pinnacle Utilities, LLC (collectively, the "Applicant") in a request for a Land Use Information Form ("LUCS") for the Oregon Water Resources Department ("OWRD"). This letter provides additional information regarding that request.

Applicant seeks to transfer the place of use and type of use of 50.00 acres of C-95746, to provide quasi-municipal water to the Thornburgh Destination Resort. Quasi-municipal water is defined under state rule.

To clarify any misunderstanding, a quasi-municipal water use is defined as is relevant at OAR 690-300-0010(40):

"Quasi-Municipal Water Use" means the delivery and use of water through the water service system of a corporation other than a public corporation created for the purpose of operating a water supply system, for those uses usual and ordinary to municipal water use, or a federally recognized Indian tribe that operates a water supply system for uses usual and ordinary to a municipal water use.

That definition refers to uses that are "usual and ordinary to municipal water use", which is defined at OAR 690-300-0010(29):

"Municipal Water Use" means the delivery and use of water through the water service system of a municipal corporation for all water uses usual and ordinary to such systems. Examples of these water uses shall include but are not limited to domestic water use, irrigation of lawns and gardens, commercial water use, industrial water use, fire protection, irrigation and other water uses in park and

recreation facilities, and street washing. Such uses shall not include generation of hydroelectric power.

As is relevant to the LUCS, any number of uses allowed under a quasi-municipal water right are permitted outright in EFU lands, including "irrigation" use.

More importantly, the Applicant (or its affiliates), has also received final master plan approval for a destination resort on the same lands. Applicant has also received tentative plan approval and related infrastructure including road and facility systems, site plan approval for a golf course and related infrastructure, overnight lodging unit ("OLU") site plan approval, and is pursuing a number of other applications. On October 22, 2021, OWRD received your water right Permanent Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$7300.00. Our receipt number 136679 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change. A review form will also be sent to our groundwater staff to determine whether the proposed well accesses the same source of water as the original well.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water for the new use or in the new place of use until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.



Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Transfer Application. (Application Number: T-13857)

- Authority. The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any
 applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In
 making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
- Restrictions. Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
- 3. Effective Date and Duration. Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.

4. Consideration.

- a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$2,451.17. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$2,451.17 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.

The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

- 7. Termination. Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
- 8. Funds Authorized and Available. By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
- 9. Duration of Estimate. The Estimate of Time to completion is approximately 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
- 10. Completion Date. OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information. IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19 and actions taken by the State of Oregon to facilitate teleworking as a tool to help prevent the spread of the disease, Department processes for Reimbursement Authority may be unavoidably delayed.
- 11. Captions. The captions or headings in this Agreement are for the convenience only and in no way define, limit, or describe the scope, or intent, of any provision of this Agreement.
