We lived there for eighteen years and paid the property taxes on river frontage (which was not cheap). We had a pump in the river from the second month that we were there. It was there the entire eighteen years. We also had permission from the County to put a dock in the river for our fishing boat and jet boat as long as it did not extend into the river more than 12 feet. It was still there when we left and so was the pump. We had Riparian water rights.

We purchased the property from Sigmund and Ann Snelson. They live in California. They were in Ventura on Coldwater Canyon Road. I am not sure that they are still there but they are probably around there somewhere. At no time did John Day have any of our river frontage I am sure that this could be checked out. US Bank paid our taxes for us and received our tax bill the entire time that we lived there. I hope this helps you and if you need anything further, please contact me again.

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
