- Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the
 existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer
 Application T-13916.
- The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 10. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 12. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13916 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:







Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. On February 7, 2022, OWRD received your water right Permanent Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$2450.00. Our receipt number 137432 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water for the new use until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.






