- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on March 1, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On March 27, 2023, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination to the applicant, proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13919. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter gave a deadline of April 28, 2023, for the applicant to respond. On February 11, 2022, OWRD received your water right Permanent Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$1970.00. Our receipt number 137457 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water for the new use until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department. In order to avoid any possible forfeiture of the water right, you should continue to use the water as described by your existing water right.

If the land is sold before the application is approved, the buyer's consent to the application will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.
