- On February 14, 2022, Robert Russell and TU filed an application to change a portion of the place of use and character of use under Certificate 86767 to instream use. The Department assigned the application number T-13920.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on February 22, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were received by the comment deadline, March 24, 2022. Consistent with land use requirements, notice of the intent to file the instream transfer application was provided by the applicant to Jackson County Planning Department and City of Eagle Point Public Works. 15. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.

- 16. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 17. The amount and timing of the proposed instream flow is allowable within the limits and use of the original water right.
- 18. The protection of flows at the authorized point of diversion is appropriate, considering:
 - a) The instream water right begins at the recorded point of diversion;
 - b) The location of confluences with other streams downstream of the point of diversion;
 - There are known areas of natural loss of streamflow to the river bed downstream from the point of diversion; and
 - d) Any return flows resulting from the exercise of the existing water right would re-enter the river downstream of the point of the instream water right.
- 19. Within the proposed instream protection on Little Butte Creek, there is an existing instream water rights established under ORS 537.348 (instream transfer process) for the purpose of maintaining instream flow for fisheries enhancement. There is also a pending instream water right application IS-88945, filed by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife pursuant to ORS 537.341 (state agency application process), with the Department to establish an instream water right on Little Butte Creek for the purposes of conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, and fish and wildlife habitat.

Conclusions of Law







6. Notice of this transfer will need to be published in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water rights are currently located. You will be responsible for the charges.

What happens next...

Once the Preliminary Determination is issued a publication period is required. Because of a change in character of use, the Department will publish notice of the transfer in a local newspaper having a general circulation in the area of the water right at least once per week for two consecutive weeks. You are responsible for sending a check to cover the cost of publication prior to the issuance of the Preliminary Determination and publication of notice. As outlined in OAR 690-380-4020(3), publication costs include both the direct cost of the notice and indirect processing costs (not to exceed 20% of the direct costs) for processing.

Issuance of the Preliminary Determination will occur shortly after we receive:

 Your written response to the conditions and proposed action in the Draft Preliminary Determination (e-mail is acceptable); and

2. The Report of Ownership, including affidavits of consent from any landowners shown in the ownership report who have not signed the transfer application. The title company must indicate/state the date that they prepared the ownership report on the coversheet and/or first page of the report.

If we do not receive the items listed above by May 19, 2022, a Preliminary Determination may be issued denying the application as incomplete.

The applicant has also requested that any instream water rights established as a result of this instream transfer replace a portion of any existing instream rights established pursuant to ORS 537.346 (minimum streamflow).

- 13. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 14. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 15. The amount and timing of the proposed instream flow is allowable within the limits and use of the original water right.
- 16. The protection of flows at the authorized point of diversion is appropriate, considering:
 - a) The instream water right begins at the recorded point of diversion;
 - b) The location of confluences with other streams downstream of the point of diversion;
 - There are known areas of natural loss of streamflow to the river bed downstream from the point of diversion; and
 - d) Any return flows resulting from the exercise of the existing water right would re-enter the river downstream of the point of the instream water right.

- 17. Within the proposed instream protection on Little Butte Creek, there is an existing instream water rights established under ORS 537.348 (instream transfer process) for the purpose of maintaining instream flow for fisheries enhancement. Any instream water right established as a result of this instream transfer will replace a portion of any existing instream rights established pursuant to ORS 537.346 (minimum streamflow conversion) and ORS 537.341 (state agency instream application process), with a more senior priority date.
- 19. The total monthly quantities of water to be protected under the existing and proposed instream right at the point will provide for a beneficial purpose and do not exceed the estimated average natural flow.

Determination and Proposed Action

The changes in character of use and place of use to instream use proposed in application T-13920 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580, ORS 537.348, OAR 690-380-5000, and OAR 690-077-0075. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-13920 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The changes in character of use and place of use to instream use proposed in application T-13920 are approved.
- Water right certificate 86767 is cancelled. A new certificate confirming the instream water right shall be issued. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of the right not affected by this transfer.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.






