Conclusions of Law

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The temporary change in places of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-13958 is approved, as conditioned below.
- The land from which the water right described by Water Right Certificate 89373 is temporarily removed shall not receive any water under the rights during the 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, and 2026 irrigation seasons.
- All uses of water under this temporary transfer shall revert automatically to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2026 irrigation season, or earlier, if requested in writing by the applicant.
- 4. Any subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificate 89373 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- The time during which water is used on the proposed lands under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture of Certificate 89373 under ORS 540.610.
- The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 89373.
- The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 89373 not involved in this
 transfer shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of those
