

If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not use water for the new use, in the new place of use or from the new point of diversion/appropriation until a final order approving the transfer application has been issued by the Department.
