

Findings of Fact

1. On April 27, 2022, CRISTIAN RODRIGUEZ filed an application to temporarily add a point of diversion under Certificate 55267 for the remainder of the 2022 irrigation season or the term of the Governor's declared drought, whichever is shorter. The Department assigned the application number T-13992.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on May 10, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. The applicant requested the temporary additional point of diversion be temporarily approved starting with the 2022 irrigation season and extending through the 2027 irrigation season. Under OAR 690-019-0055(4) The expiration date for the temporary drought transfer granted pursuant to this rule shall not exceed one year or the term of the Governor's declared drought, whichever is shorter, unless otherwise renewed pursuant to OAR 690-019-0085.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Temporary Drought Transfer Review Criteria

6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
8. The Governor issued an executive order on April 7, 2022, declaring a state of drought emergency in Jackson County due to drought and extreme weather conditions, which is still in effect and the water right proposed for transfer is on lands included in the area covered by the drought order.
9. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
10. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under OAR 690-019-055(3) if injury to existing water rights is shown and cannot be mitigated to the satisfaction of the Director and injured parties.

Conclusions of Law


The temporary additional point of diversion proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13992 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0055.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The temporary additional point of diversion proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-13992 is approved.
2. The approval of this temporary drought transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
3. The proposed additional point of diversion shall revert to the authorized point of diversion at the end of the 2022 irrigation season or the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.
4. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of diversion/appropriation with the exception that water rights issued to the Bureau of Reclamation, or an irrigation district (or similar entity) are not subject to this condition.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
5. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 55267 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 55267.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22-06

**DETERMINATION OF A STATE OF DROUGHT EMERGENCY IN
GILLIAM, HARNEY, AND JACKSON COUNTIES.**

At the request of Gilliam County (by Resolution No. R2022-03, dated March 16, 2022, adopted by the Gilliam County Court), Harney County (by Resolution No. 2022-03, dated March 16, 2022, adopted by the Harney County Court), and Jackson County (by Order No. 47-22, dated March 23, 2022, ordered by the Jackson County Board of Commissioners) and based on the recommendations of the Drought Readiness Council and the Water Supply Availability Committee, and pursuant to ORS 536.740, I find the low snowpack, low reservoir levels, and low streamflow have caused or will cause natural and economic disaster conditions in Gilliam, Harney, and Jackson Counties.

Forecasted water supply conditions and precipitation levels are not expected to improve. Drought is likely to have a significant economic impact on the farm, ranch, vineyard, recreation, and natural resources sectors, as well as an impact on drinking water, fish and wildlife, and important minimum flows for public instream uses and other natural resources dependent on adequate precipitation, stored water, and streamflow in these areas. Extreme conditions are expected to affect local growers, increase the potential for fire, shorten the growing season, and decrease water supplies.

Conditions continue to be monitored by the State's natural resource and public safety agencies, including the Oregon Water Resources Department, the Oregon Office of Emergency Management, the Oregon Office of the State Fire Marshal, and the Oregon Department of Forestry's Fire Protection Division.

Preparation and resiliency to drought are vital to the health and safety of persons, property, and the economic security of the citizens and businesses of these counties. I, therefore, declare that a severe, continuing drought emergency exists and is likely to continue to exist in Gilliam, Harney, and Jackson Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED AND ORDERED:

- I. The Oregon Department of Agriculture is directed to coordinate and provide assistance in seeking federal resources to mitigate drought conditions and assist in agricultural recovery in Gilliam, Harney, and Jackson Counties.



On April 27, 2022, OWRD received your water right Temporary Transfer Application. The application was accompanied by \$200.00. Our receipt number 138004 is enclosed.

By copy of this letter, we are asking the Watermaster for a report regarding the potential for injury to existing water rights which may be caused by the requested change.

Except as provided under ORS 540.510(3) for municipalities, you may not **temporarily** use water at the new place of use or from the new point of diversion/appropriation until a final order approving the temporary transfer application has been issued by the Department. Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands from which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land to which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season. If the temporary transfer is approved during an irrigation season and water has already been used at the currently authorized location during that season, then the temporary transfer will not take effect until the following season.

If the land is sold before the temporary transfer is approved, the buyer's consent to the temporary transfer will be required unless a recorded deed or other legal document clearly established that the water right was not conveyed in the sale.

If #1, #2, #3, #4 or #5 on this checklist is deficient, the application cannot be accepted. It should be returned and the deficiencies listed in the "staff" section at the bottom of Application Page 1, unless the applicant or agent can resolve the deficiencies within 2-3 days.
