Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 536.750 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the use, place of use or point of diversion of water in the event of a declaration of drought, without complying with the notice and waiting requirements under ORS 540.520. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 019 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating drought transfer applications.

- On May 9, 2022, DUANE MARTIN RANCHES, LP filed an application to temporarily change the place of use and change the point appropriation under Certificate 41860 for the remainder of the 2022 irrigation season or the term of the Governor's declared drought, whichever is shorter. The Department assigned the application number T-14002.
- Notice of the application for transfer was published on May 25, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Temporary Drought Transfer Review Criteria

- Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.

- 8. The Governor issued an executive order on March 4, 2022, declaring a state of drought emergency in Klamath County due to drought and extreme weather conditions, which is still in effect and the water right proposed for transfer is on lands included in the area covered by the drought order.
- 9. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 10. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under OAR 690-019-055(3) if injury to existing water rights is shown and cannot be mitigated to the satisfaction of the Director and injured parties.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary change in the place of use and change in point appropriation proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-14002 is are consistent with the requirements of ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0055.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The temporary change in the place of use and change in point appropriation proposed in Temporary Drought Transfer Application T-14002 is approved.
- The former places of use shall not be irrigated as part of these water rights during the remainder of the 2022 irrigation season or until the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.
- The approval of this temporary drought transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- The use of water at the temporary places of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 41860. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2022 irrigation season.
- The proposed change in place of use and point of appropriation shall revert to the authorized place of use and point of appropriation at the end of the 2022 irrigation season or the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.

7. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 41860 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 41860.





Additionally, pursuant to OAR 690-380-8010, the lands <u>from</u> which an irrigation water right is to be temporarily transferred and the land <u>to</u> which the right is to be temporarily transferred may not both receive water during the same season.
