The ground under the portion of Permit S-54980 that is associated with this transfer is irrigated with flood irrigation and seepage from flood canals and flooded fields. Willow Creek Reservoir releases water into Willow Creek and flows approximately 17.5 miles to POD #3. The water is diverted from Willow Creek at POD #3 with a low lift 10 hp, 6.62 cfs, propeller pump and discharged into a main ditch. The main ditch has a capacity of 9.8 cfs. It is an earthen ditch which transports the irrigation water to the POU. There is also a secondary ditch which branches off the main ditch which is used to provide flood irrigation and seepage irrigation to the POU. The capacity of the secondary ditch is 11.1 cfs. Refer to the COBU report for Transfer T-9454 on file with the OWRD for specific details on the pump and canals.
