Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

1. On September 12, 2022, CITY OF JUNCTION CITY filed an application to add additional points of appropriation under Permits G-12057 and G-12121. The Department assigned the application number T-14086.
2. On November 1, 2019, the Department approved an extension of time for Permit G-12057 for complete application of water to October 1, 2049.
3. On November 1, 2019, the Department approved an extension of time for Permit G-12121 for complete application of water to October 1, 2049.
4. On February 21, 2020, the Department approved a Water Management and Conservation Plan for Permits G-12057 and G-12121 recorded in Special Order Volume 116, pages 160-161.
5. On February 16, 2023, the Department received revised application pages and maps adding an additional point of appropriation to the proposed change.
6. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on September 27, 2022, and in the Junction City Union newspaper on October 16 and 23, 2024, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5).

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law


The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-14086 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-14086 are approved.
2. Approval of this permit amendment application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new points of appropriation.
3. Permit G-18892, in the name of CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, is issued to replace Permit G-12057, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, the Extension of Time and the Water Management and Conservation Plan. Permit G-12057, in the name of CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, is no longer of any force or effect.

4. Permit G-18893, in the name of CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, is issued to replace Permit G-12121, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, the Extension of Time and the Water Management and Conservation Plan. Permit G-12121, in the name of CITY OF JUNCTION CITY, is no longer of any force or effect.
5. For Permit G-12057, the combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (15th & Oaklea and Raintree Meadows), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (13th & Elm), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (13th & Elm).
6. For Permit G-12121, the combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (15th & Oaklea and Raintree Meadows), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (8th & Deal), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (8th & Deal).
7. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
8. For Permit G-12057, to meet the current conditions of the existing permit, both additional points of appropriation will need to be altered such that solid casing and seal extend continuously to 100 feet below land surface.
9. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
10. All other terms and conditions of Permits G-18892 and G-18893 remain the same.

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation (15th & Oaklea and Raintree Meadows), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (13th & Elm), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (13th & Elm).

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation (13th & Elm).

WMCP Conditions:**Duration of Plan Approval:**

The City of Junction City Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until February 14, 2030, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

Development Limitations:

The limitation of the diversion of water under Permits G-12121 and G-12057 established in the Final Orders approving Extensions of Time for Permits G-12121 and G-12057 (*issued on November 1, 2019*) remains unchanged. Subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, therefore, the City of Junction City remains authorized to divert only up to 0.77 cfs (*out of the total permitted 2.23 cfs*) of water under Permit G-12121 and up to 1.60 cfs (*out of the total permitted 2.23 cfs*) of water under Permit G-12057.

Plan Update Schedule:

The City of Junction City shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 within 10 years and no later than August 14, 2029.

Progress Report Schedule:

The City of Junction City shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by February 14, 2025.

Other Requirements for Plan Submittal:

The deadline established herein for the submittal of an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan (consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 086) shall not relieve the City of Junction City from any existing or future requirement(s) for submittal of a Water Management and Conservation Plan at an earlier date as established through other final orders of the Department.

Extension of Time Conditions:**Development Limitations**

A maximum appropriation of 1.60 cfs of water is currently allowed under Permit G-12057. Any appropriation of water beyond 1.60 cfs (not to exceed the maximum amount authorized under the permit, being 2.23 cfs) shall only be authorized upon issuance of a final order approving a Water Management and Conservation Plan (WMCP) under OAR Chapter 690, Division 86 that authorizes access to a greater rate of appropriation of water under the permit consistent with OAR 690-086-0130(7). The required WMCP shall be submitted to the Department within 3 years of this Final Order. The amount of water used under Permit G-12057 must be consistent with this and subsequent WMCP's approved under OAR Chapter 690, Division 86 on file with the Department.

The Development Limitation established in the above paragraph supersedes any prior limitation of the appropriation of water under Permit G-12057 that has been established under a prior WMCP or Extension final order issued by the Department.

The deadline established in the Extension Final Order for submittal of a WMCP shall not relieve a permit holder of any existing or future requirement for submittal of a WMCP at an earlier date as established through other orders of the Department. A WMCP submitted to meet the requirements of the final order may also meet the WMCP submittal requirements of other Department orders.

Original Permit Conditions:**Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:**

A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall develop a plan to monitor and report the impact of water use under this permit on water levels within the aquifer that provides water to the permitted well(s). The plan shall be submitted to the Department within one year of the date the permit is issued and shall be subject to the approval of the Department. At a minimum, the plan shall include a program to periodically measure static water levels within the permitted well(s) or an adequate substitute such as water levels in nearby wells. The plan shall also stipulate a reference water level against which any water-level declines will be compared. If a well listed on this permit (or replacement well) displays a total static water-level decline of 25 or more feet over any period of years, as compared to the reference level, then the water user shall discontinue use of, or reduce the rate or volume of withdrawal from, the well(s). Such action shall be taken until the water level recovers to above the 25-foot decline level or until the Department determines, based on the water user's and/or the Department's data and analysis, that no action is necessary because the aquifer in question can sustain the observed declines without adversely impacting the resource or senior water rights. The water user shall in no instance allow excessive decline, as defined in Commission rules, to occur within the aquifer as a result of use under this permit.

Within 2 years of permit issuance, the permittee shall submit a water management and conservation plan consistent with OAR Chapter 690, Division 86.

Groundwater production shall be from no shallower than 100 feet below land surface.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.


This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

The original permit was issued December 22, 1995. Actual construction work was to begin within one year from issuance of the original permit. By Extension of Time Final order dated November 1, 2019, the deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 1997, to October 1, 2049. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 1998, to October 1, 2049.

Any appropriation of water beyond 0.77 cfs (not to exceed the maximum amount authorized under the permit, being 2.23 cfs) shall only be authorized upon issuance of a final order approving a Water Management and Conservation Plan (WMCP) under OAR Chapter 690, Division 86 that authorizes access to a greater rate of appropriation of water under the permit consistent with OAR 690-086-0130(7). The required WMCP shall be submitted to the Department within 3 years of this Final Order. The amount of water used under Permit G-12121 must be consistent with this and subsequent WMCP's approved under OAR Chapter 690, Division 86 on file with the Department.

The Development Limitation established in the above paragraph supersedes any prior limitation of the appropriation of water under Permit G-12121 that has been established under a prior WMCP or Extension final order issued by the Department.

The deadline established in this Extension Final Order for submittal of a WMCP shall not relieve a permit holder of any existing or future requirement for submittal of a WMCP at an earlier date as established through other orders of the Department. A WMCP submitted to meet the requirements of this final order may also meet the WMCP submittal requirements of other Department orders.

Original Permit Conditions:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Within one year from the date the Water Resources Commission adopts rules describing the schedules, standards and procedures for water conservation management plans by water suppliers, the city shall submit a plan which is consistent with said rules.

Within one year of permit issuance, the city shall prepare a plan/timetable for the Water Resources Commission which shall indicate the steps which the City intends to pursue to obtain a long-term water supply.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

The original permit was issued August 29, 1995. Actual construction work was to begin on or before August 29, 1996, and was to be completed on or before October 1, 1997. And complete application of water was to be made on or before October 1, 1998. By Extension of Time Final order dated November 1, 2019, the deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 1997, to October 1, 2049. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 1998, to October 1, 2049.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.


This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has found that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

The fine-grained sediments will limit the efficiency of the hydraulic connection with Flat Creek and will distribute impacts to surface water due to groundwater pumping over a broad area and longer time. Most surface water depletion due to groundwater pumping will still occur within the same Water Availability Basin as the authorized POA. As such, the proposed change is unlikely to injure surface water rights.

In order to comply with the conditions of Permit G-12057, both proposed APOA will need to be altered such that solid casing and seal extend continuously to 100 feet below land surface.




Well Location Map



Purpose The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Transfer Application. (Application Number: T-14086)

1. **Authority.** The OWRD has been authorized pursuant to ORS 536.055 to enter into a voluntary agreement with any applicant, permittee or regulated entity (collectively Applicant) for expediting or enhancing a regulatory process. In making this agreement, OWRD shall require the applicant to pay the full cost of expedited process.
2. **Restrictions.** Applicant and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD. OWRD shall be free to exercise independent judgment consistent with existing laws and regulations.
3. **Effective Date and Duration.** Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement and the full deposit of the estimated cost of the proposed service.
4. **Consideration.**
 - a. Applicant shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. The estimated maximum reimbursement payable to OWRD under this Agreement is \$2,505.62. Applicant agrees to pay the full amount of \$2,505.62 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work stated in this Agreement. This payment will be placed in an account administered by OWRD and drawn upon as costs are actually incurred. If the actual cost of performing the work is less than payments received, OWRD will refund the unspent balance. If the actual cost of processing exceeds the estimate, the Applicant can either elect to terminate this Agreement or amend the Agreement to reflect the increase in cost.
 - b. The costs stated in this Agreement do not include the statutory application processing and filing fees.
5. **Confidentiality.** Applicant agrees that any information provided to or acquired by OWRD under this Agreement will be subject to the Oregon Public Records Law and shall be considered public records.
6. **Indemnity.** Applicant shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify the State of Oregon, OWRD, and their officers, employees, and agents from and against all claims, suits, actions, losses, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses of any nature resulting from or arising out of, or relating to the activities of Applicant or its representatives, officers, employees, contractors, or agents under this Agreement or with respect to the expedited service. The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

7. **Termination.** Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at anytime during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by OWRD up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance.
8. **Funds Authorized and Available.** By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certify that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
9. **Duration of Estimate.** The Estimate of Time to completion is **approximately** 120 days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate. NOTE: Any time estimate is approximate; No guarantee of Final Order issuance of a date is certain. Duration estimates do not include any statutory waiting periods.
10. **Completion Date.** OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information.
11. **Captions.** The captions or headings in this Agreement are for the convenience only and in no way define, limit, or describe the scope, or intent, of any provision of this Agreement.
12. **Amendment and Merger.** The terms of this Agreement shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented, or amended in any manner whatsoever, except by written instrument signed by both parties. Such waiver, consent, modification or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. There are no understandings, agreements or representations, oral or written, not specified herein regarding this Agreement.
