Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- On November 17, 2022, Golden Rule Farms, Inc. filed an application for additional point of appropriation, a change in points of appropriation, a change in place of use and a change in character of use under Certificate 94472. The Department assigned the application number T-14121.
- Notice of the application for transfer was published on November 22, 2022, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On June 6, 2024, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-14121 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of July 8, 2024, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On December 10, 2024, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-14121 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on December 17, 2024, and in the Burns Times Herald newspaper on December 18 and 24, 2024, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notices.
- 5. The right to be transferred is as follows:

- 8. To clarify the changes in points of appropriation; upon issuance of the final order the authorized points of appropriation will include, Well 18, POA A, POA B, #18A, and POA C.
- 9. Transfer Application T-14121 proposes to change the character of use to irrigation.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2), 690-380-2110(2), 690-380-2200, 690-380-2300, and 690-250-0070(1)]

- 10. A confirming Certificate has been issued within the five years prior to the submittal of Transfer Application T-14121. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14121.
- 12. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).

- 13. The proposed points of appropriation develop groundwater from the same aquifer as the authorized points of appropriation, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).
- 14. To prevent enlargement of the transferred right. The proposed irrigation use shall be limited to:
 - a) A place of use of 21.6 acres (0.27 cfs/0.0125 cfs per acre) as described in Finding No.
 6 above.
 - b) A rate of diversion not to exceed 0.27 cfs, further limited to a total quantity of water diverted of 64.8 acre-feet (3.0 acre-feet per acre) during the irrigation season of each year.
 - c) A period of use (irrigation season), authorized under OAR 690-250-0070(1), of March 1 to October 31 of each year.
- 15. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 16. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would not result in injury to other existing water rights.
- 17. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in points of appropriation, additional point of appropriation, change in place of use, and change in character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14121 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in points of appropriation, additional point of appropriation, change in place of use, and change in character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14121 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 94472 and any related decree.
- Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new points of appropriation and the new place of use.
- 4. Water right Certificate 94472 is cancelled.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (POA A, POA B, and #18A) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 6, WELL 7, WELL 13, and WELL 18).

- The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (POA C), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (WELL 6, WELL 7, WELL 13, and WELL 18), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 6, WELL 7, WELL 13, and WELL 18).
- Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 9. The proposed irrigation use shall be limited to:
 - A place of use of 21.6 acres (0.27 cfs/0.0125 cfs per acre), as described in Finding of Fact No. 7.
 - A rate of diversion not to exceed 0.27 cfs, further limited to a total quantity of water diverted of 64.8 acre-feet (3.0 acre-feet per acre x 21.6 acres) during the irrigation season of each year.
 - c) A period of use (irrigation season), authorized under OAR 690-250-0070(1), of March 1 to October 31 of each year.
- 10. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice

- 11. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2026. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 12. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-0100(14), 690-380-4010(2), 690-380-2110(2), 690-380-2200, 690-380-2300, and 690-250-0070(1)]

- A confirming Certificate has been issued within the five years prior to the submittal of Transfer Application T-14121. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 9. A water delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-14121.
- The water right is subject to transfer as defined in ORS 540.505(4) and OAR 690-380-0100(14).
- 11. The proposed points of appropriation develop groundwater from the same aquifer as the authorized points of appropriation, as required by OAR 690-380-2110(2).

Determination and Proposed Action

The change in points of appropriation, additional point of appropriation, change in place of use, and change in character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14121 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-14121 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The change in points of appropriation, additional point of appropriation, a change in place of use, and change in character of use proposed in Transfer Application T-14121 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 94472 and any related decree.
- 3. Approval of this transfer application does not constitute nor grant legal access onto or through another person's property for purposes of accessing the new points of appropriation and the new place of use.
- 4. Water right Certificate 94472 is cancelled.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (POA A, POA B, and #18A) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 6, WELL 7, WELL 13, and WELL 18).
- 6. The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (POA C), together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation (WELL 6, WELL 7, WELL 13, and WELL 18), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (WELL 6, WELL 7, WELL 13, and WELL 18).
- 7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 8. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.

- 9. The proposed irrigation use shall be limited to:
 - a) A place of use of 21.6 acres (0.27 cfs/0.0125 cfs per acre), as described in Finding No. 6 above.
 - b) A rate of diversion not to exceed 0.27 cfs, further limited to a total quantity of water diverted of 64.8 acre-feet (3.0 acre-feet per acre x 21.6 acres) during the irrigation season of each year.
 - c) A period of use (irrigation season), authorized under OAR 690-250-0070(1), of March 1 to October 31 of each year.
- 10. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice
- 11. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2026.** A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 12. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Protests

Under the provisions of ORS 540.520(6) & (7) and OAR 690-380-4030, within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later, any person may file, jointly or severally, a protest expressing opposition of approval of the transfer application and disagreement with this Preliminary Determination or a standing statement in support of this Preliminary Determination. If this Preliminary Determination determines that a change in point of diversion or appropriation would result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050. Protests and standing statements must be received by the Water Resources Department within 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later.

Protests must be in writing and received in hard copy form with the appropriate statutory protest filing fee; protests cannot be filed by electronic mail. [OAR 690-002-0025(3) and 690-380-0100(9)]. The protest must include the following:

- The person's name, address, and telephone number;
- All reasonably ascertainable issues and all reasonably available arguments supporting the person's position by the close of the protest period. Failure to raise a reasonably ascertainable issue in a protest or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the Department an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude consideration of the issue during the hearing;
- If you are the applicant, a protest fee of \$480 required by ORS 536.050; and
- If you are not the applicant, a protest fee of \$950 required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of OAR 690-380-4030(5), the Department shall provide to persons who have filed standing statements as defined under OAR 690-380-0100(11) notice of any differences between the Department's Preliminary Determination and the Final Order, notice of a hearing on the application under OAR 137-003-0535, and an opportunity to request limited party status or party status in the hearing.

Requests for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than 30 days after the last date of publication of the newspaper notice or the Department's weekly notice as prescribed by OAR 690-380-4020, whichever is later. Requests for standing must be in writing, and must include the following:

- The requester's name, mailing address and telephone number;
- If the requester is representing a group, association or other organization, the name, address and telephone number of the represented group;
- A statement that the requester supports the preliminary determination as issued.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a Final Order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been filed under OAR 690-380-4030. In accordance with OAR 690-380-4200, notice and conduct of the hearing shall:

- Be under the applicable provisions of ORS 183.310 to 183.550, pertaining to contested cases, and the hearing shall be held in the area where the rights are located unless all parties stipulate otherwise; and
- If a protest has asserted that a water right to be transferred has been forfeited through non-use, include the notice and procedures described in OAR 690-017-0500 to 690-017-0900.

If after hearing the Department issues a proposed Final Order finding that a change in point of diversion or appropriation will result in injury, the applicant may file a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under OAR 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050 within 15 days of receipt of the proposed order. Notwithstanding 690-002-0175, if the applicant files a notification of intent to pursue approval of the transfer under 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050, the deadline for filing exceptions to the proposed order shall be 30 days after the Department provides notice to the parties that the transfer does not meet the requirements of 690-380-5030 to 690-380-5050.

If you do not request a hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period, or if you withdraw a request for a hearing, notify the Department or the administrative law judge that you will not appear, or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director may issue a final order by default. If the Director issues a Final Order by default, the Department designates the relevant portions of its files on this matter, including all materials that you have submitted relating to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a *prima facie* case upon default.

You may be represented by an attorney at the hearing. Legal aid organizations may be able to assist a party with limited financial resources. Generally, partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions, or public or private organizations are represented by an attorney. However, consistent with OAR 690-002-0020 and OAR 690-137-0555, an agency representative may represent partnerships, corporations, associations, governmental subdivisions or public, or private organizations if the Department determines that appearance of a person by an authorized representative will not hinder the orderly and timely development of the record in this case.

Your water right transfer is in the first of three phases of processing. Enclosed is a draft of the Department's Preliminary Determination regarding Transfer Application T-14121. The document reflects the Department's conclusion that, based on the information currently available, the transfer will be approved. Your response and submittal of the items outlined below are required by April 8, 2024.

Required items needing your immediate attention:

- 1. Please carefully review the Draft Preliminary Determination to verify that it accurately reflects the changes you intend to make and to become familiar with the proposed conditions.
- 2. Respond in writing by April 8, 2024, with acknowledgement that you agree to the proposed action and conditions.
- 3. If you find any errors, please let me know.
- REQUIRED: You must submit a Report of Ownership for the lands where the water right are currently located (i.e., the FROM lands). This report:
 - a) Must be prepared by a title company;
 - Shall include a "prepared by" statement and the date the title company prepared the report printed on the cover sheet;
 - c) Must:
 - i. Be prepared no earlier than 3 months prior to the date of issuance of the Draft Preliminary Determination showing current ownership; OR
 - ii. Be prepared within 3 months of the date the water right conveyance agreement was recorded; OR
 - iii. Show ownership for the FROM land at the time a water right conveyance agreement was recorded.

If water right conveyance agreements are involved, it is helpful to provide copies of those agreements along with the Report of Ownership.

IMPORTANT: In order for the Department to clearly understand the date that the title company prepared the Report of Ownership, the title company must indicate/state the date that they prepared the report on the coversheet and/or first page of the report.

- d) Must include a list of owners at the time the report was generated; AND
- e) Must include a legal description of the property where the water right to be transferred is currently located (i.e., the FROM lands).
- 5. You must provide a notarized statement of consent signed by any landowner listed in the Report of Ownership who is <u>not</u> already included in the transfer application. The Department's statement of consent form (Consent By Deeded Landowner) is available at:

https://www.oregon.gov/OWRD/WRDFormsPDF/consent to transfer form.pdf

6. Notice of this transfer will need to be published in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water rights are currently located. You will be responsible for the charges.

Conditions of your water right...

The Watermaster has required water measurement devices at the new and existing points of appropriation prior to diversion of water. Enclosed is a contact information sheet to assist you in pursuing additional information or approval of the required (or alternate) device(s).

The proposed irrigation use shall be limited to:

- A place of use of 21.6 acres (0.27 cfs/0.0125 cfs per acre).
- A rate of diversion not to exceed 0.27 cfs, further limited to a total quantity of water diverted of 64.8 acre-feet (3.0 acre-feet per acre) during the irrigation season of each year.
- A period of use (irrigation season) of March 1 to October 31 of each year.

Please note the proposed date by which all conditions must be met: October 1, 2025. If the required completion date is insufficient to comply with any of the conditions, you may request more time, at no cost to you, during this stage of processing. Please let me know by the comment deadline if you will need more time and explain the reasons why.

What happens next...

Once the Preliminary Determination is issued a publication period is required. Because of a change in character of use, the Department will publish notice of the transfer in a local newspaper having a general circulation in the area of the water right at least once per week for two consecutive weeks. You are responsible for sending a check to cover the cost of publication prior to the issuance of the Preliminary Determination and publication of notice. As outlined in OAR 690-380-4020(3), publication costs include both the direct cost of the notice and indirect processing costs (not to exceed 20% of the direct costs) for processing.

Issuance of the Preliminary Determination will occur shortly after we receive:

- 1. Your written response to the conditions and proposed action in the Draft Preliminary Determination (e-mail is acceptable); and
- The Report of Ownership, including affidavits of consent from any landowners shown in the ownership report who have not signed the transfer application. The title company must indicate/state the date that they prepared the ownership report on the coversheet and/or first page of the report.

If we do not receive the items listed above by April 8, 2024, a Preliminary Determination may be issued denying the application as incomplete.



The currently authorized wells develop groundwater from the Older basin fill and Proximal vent deposits hydrostratigraphic units. The existing proposed wells develop groundwater from the Older basin fill hydrostratigraphic unit, and the unbuilt well will also likely develop groundwater from this unit. Other hydrostratigraphic units may also be present in this area.

Groundwater occurs in multiple hydrostratigraphic units, and groundwater within these units is hydraulically connected, making a single groundwater system composed of multiple hydrostratigraphic units (Gingerich and others, 2022).

In general, groundwater in the Harney Basin flows from several upland recharge areas to a common discharge area near Malheur and Harney Lakes, with some apparent discharge to the Malheur Basin through one or more areas along the eastern margin. While the rocks and sediments making up the aquifer system in the Harney Basin do constitute a single groundwater flow system, sub-watersheds within the basin contribute recharge to different parts of the system depending on groundwater flow-paths from recharge to discharge areas. In general, within these sub-watersheds water within the aquifer system is sourced from a common recharge area and can therefore be considered a single source.



A review form will also be sent to our groundwater staff to determine whether the proposed well accesses the same source of water as the original well or as the original POD.

This application <u>may</u> require publication of a notice for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in the area where the water right is located. If it is determined that newspaper notice will be required, the Department will prepare the notice and notify you of the cost. You will be responsible for submitting payment to the Department prior to publication of the notice.
