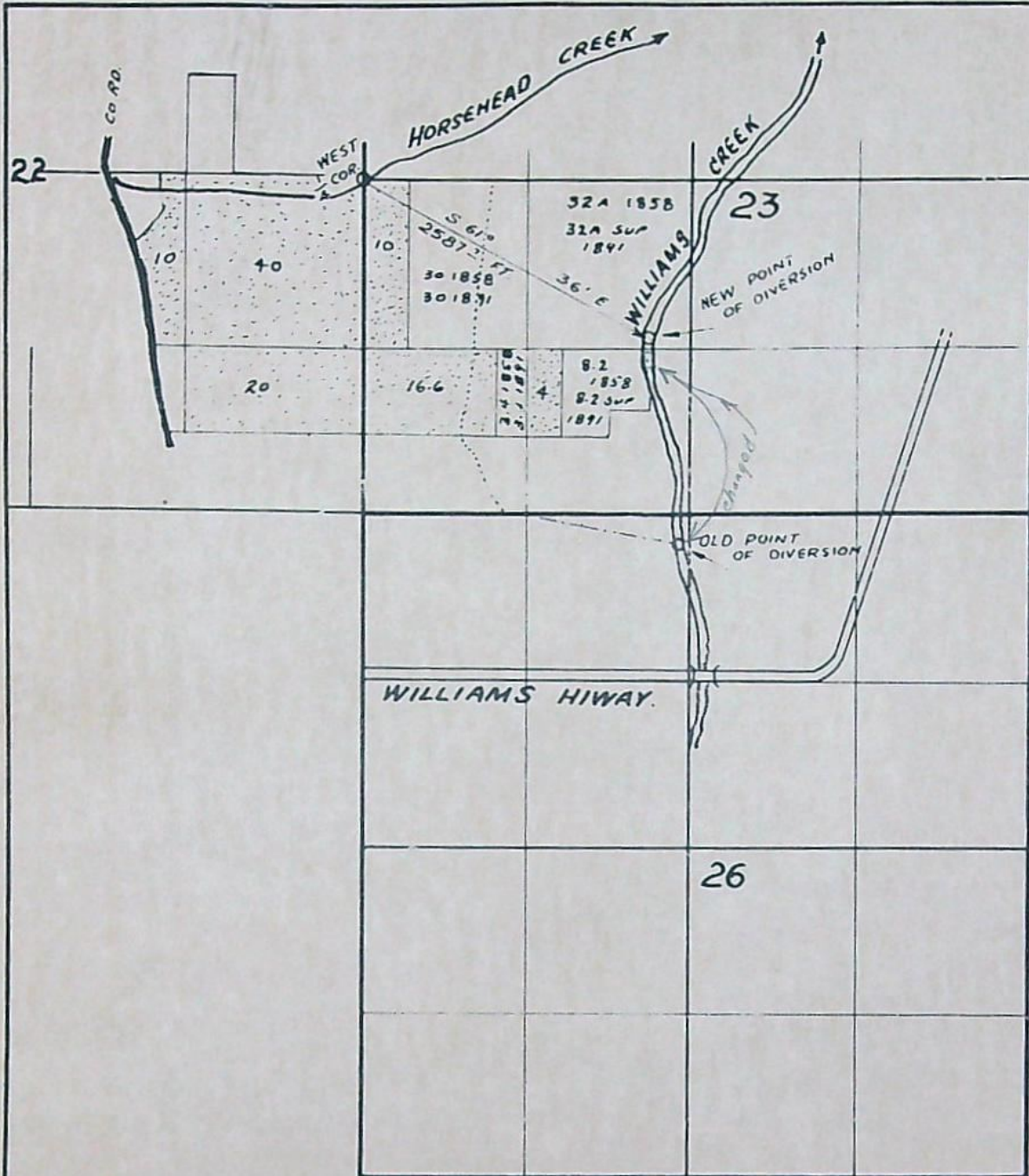

ORDER

APPROVING APPLICATION

On April 10, 1962, J. E. Ferrare of Grants Pass, Oregon, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Williams Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered April 26, 1919, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Various Claimants to the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Albert and C. O. Bigelow and George Sparlin to the use of the waters of Williams Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 32 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , 30 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M., with a date of priority of 1858. These lands are irrigated by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said pumping plant being located 1250 feet North and 400 feet West from the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 23, and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of 73.6 acres of the lands above described, to-wit: 32 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , 30 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , 3.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 8.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M., proposes to irrigate these lands by means of a pumping plant to be located South 61 degrees 36' East, 2587.7 feet from the W $\frac{1}{2}$  corner of Section 23, and being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.



Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Williams Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 1250 feet North and 400 feet West from the  $S\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 23, and being within the  $SE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

To a point to be located South 61 degrees 36' East 2587.7 feet from the  $W\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 23, and being within the  $NE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ , said Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

for the irrigation of 32 acres in the  $NE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ , 30 acres in the  $NW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ , 3.4 acres in the  $SW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$  and 8.2 acres in the  $SE\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M., with a date of priority of 1858, be and the same is hereby approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1963, or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion.



It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the pumping plant and related works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the plans of the weir or other suitable device be approved by the watermaster of Josephine County, Oregon before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

Confirming our telephone conversation of this date I am returning the application of J. E. Ferrare for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Williams Creek in order that you may confer with Mr. Donald F. Myrick, the applicant's attorney, and suggest certain changes that should be made.

On April 29, 1952, we approved an application of Earl Smith for a change in point of diversion of water from Williams Creek wherein the diversion was changed from the head of the Baltimore Ditch to a point downstream located 1250 ft. N. and 400 ft. W. from the S $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 23, and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Sec. 23, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W.M., for the irrigation of the identical acreage described in the J. E. Ferrare application. Item 4 of the application, therefore, should be amended to describe the point of diversion as above described.

Our records further indicate that there have been no other changes involving this particular land other than the order approving the Richards' application involving the supplemental right. As you will recall the point of diversion for the supplemental right was changed to a pumping plant located 750 ft. S. and 250 ft. W. from the N $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 26, and being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , said Sec. 26. If Mr. Ferrare is going to maintain this pumping plant, his application should be amended by deleting the supplemental right therefrom. Actually, since the two points of diversion are only approximately 2,000 ft. apart, the supplemental right has little, if any, significance.

In view of this, I would suggest that you read paragraph 79, page 72 of the printed Rogue River Decree to Mr. Myrick. This, in substance, states that where the lands irrigated herein described are determined to have a right to a certain quantity of water from one stream or source of supply, and are irrigated also from another stream or source, the total and entire quantity of water to which said lands are entitled from all sources shall not exceed the maximum quantity to which said lands are entitled from any such source of supply.

I would also suggest that the application be amended by striking from Item 5 any reference to changing the point of diversion involving Appn. 34475 Permit No. 27075. There is no statutory provision for changing the point of diversion under a permit. We have adopted a procedure wherein the applicant files an amended map showing the location of the proposed new diversion, which is then made a part of the file. The map accompanying the application of Mr. Ferrare will serve this purpose.

Since the distance between the proposed and present points of diversion is less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, it will not be necessary to give notice by publication, and the deposit made for this purpose will be refunded.
