FINDINGS OF FACTS

- 1. On February 28, 2005, the Department received an affidavit from Eugene E. Evers, 39439 NW Osterman Road, Forest Grove, Oregon, stating that they are the owner of lands and the water right appurtenant as evidenced by Certificate 42169, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The affidavit further states they have obtained a different source of water for primary irrigation of these lands and requests the water right be diminished from a right for primary irrigation to a right for supplemental irrigation of the lands.
- 2. The water right to be diminished is the right described by Certificate 42169, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The water right allows the use of not to exceed 0.415 cubic foot per second of water from West Fork Dairy Creek, tributary to Dairy Creek, for irrigation of 33.2 acres. The priority date is February 25, 1947. The point of diversion is located in SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, as projected within Arthur DLC 43, Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M.; 1210 feet North and 1840 feet West from the NE Corner of Conklin DLC 53.
- The affidavit requests the following lands be diminished from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation:

The quantity of water associate with the 21.5 acres equals 0.269 cubic foot per second.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Director of the Water Resources Department concludes that the portion of the right evidenced by Water Right Certificate 42169 as described in *Findings of Fact #3* has been diminished from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Certificate 42169 is canceled.
- The water right for irrigation of 21.5 acres as described by Certificate 42169 is diminished from a right for primary irrigation to a right for supplemental irrigation. The Department shall issue Certificate 81277, a new and superseding certificate, to confirm the diminution of the right

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.415 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.146 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.269 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2424

On July 24, 1970, Ever-May Farms filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from West Fork Dairy Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Albert J. Evers and recorded at page 19857, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.415 cubic foot per second of water from West Fork Dairy Creek for the irrigation of 20.8 acres in SW% SW%, 1.4 acres in SE% SW%, Section 17, 0.5 acre in NE% NW% and 10.5 acres in NW% NW%, Section 20, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 25, 1947. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 150 feet south and 390 feet west from the E% corner of Section 18 being within the NE% SE% of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located south 56° east 290 feet from the NE corner of SE% NW% being within the SE% NW% of Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Hillsboro, Oregon, on September 30, 1970, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the

<u>Washington County News-Times</u>, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Washington County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 6, 13, and 20, 1970. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from West Fork Dairy Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 150 feet south and 390 feet west from the E% corner of Section 18 being within the NE% SE% of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M.

To a point to be located south 56° east 290 feet from the NE corner of SE% NW% being within the SE% NW% of Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 20.8 acres in SW% SW%, 1.4 acres in SE% SW%, Section 17, 0.5 acre in NE% NW% and 10.5 acres in NW% NW%, Section 20, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 25, 1947, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.415 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be

carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Albert J. Evers and recorded at page 19857, Volume

14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon
receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of
the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water
right shall be issued to Ever-May Farms confirming the change in
point of diversion.
