confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, AN UNNAMED TRIBUTARY TO WOODFORD CREEK AND WOODFORD CREEK, tributaries of COW CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 22.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DOUGLAS COUNTY COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1890.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed THE RATE OF ONE CUBIC FOOT OF WATER PER SECOND OF TIME FOR EACH 70 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1320 FEET SOUTH AND 1580 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 32;

UNNAMED STREAM - NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 3550 FEET SOUTH AND 2450 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 32;

WOODFORD CREEK - NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 32 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1320 FEET NORTH AND 940 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION Approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 30, 1970, and supersedes Certificate 9650, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

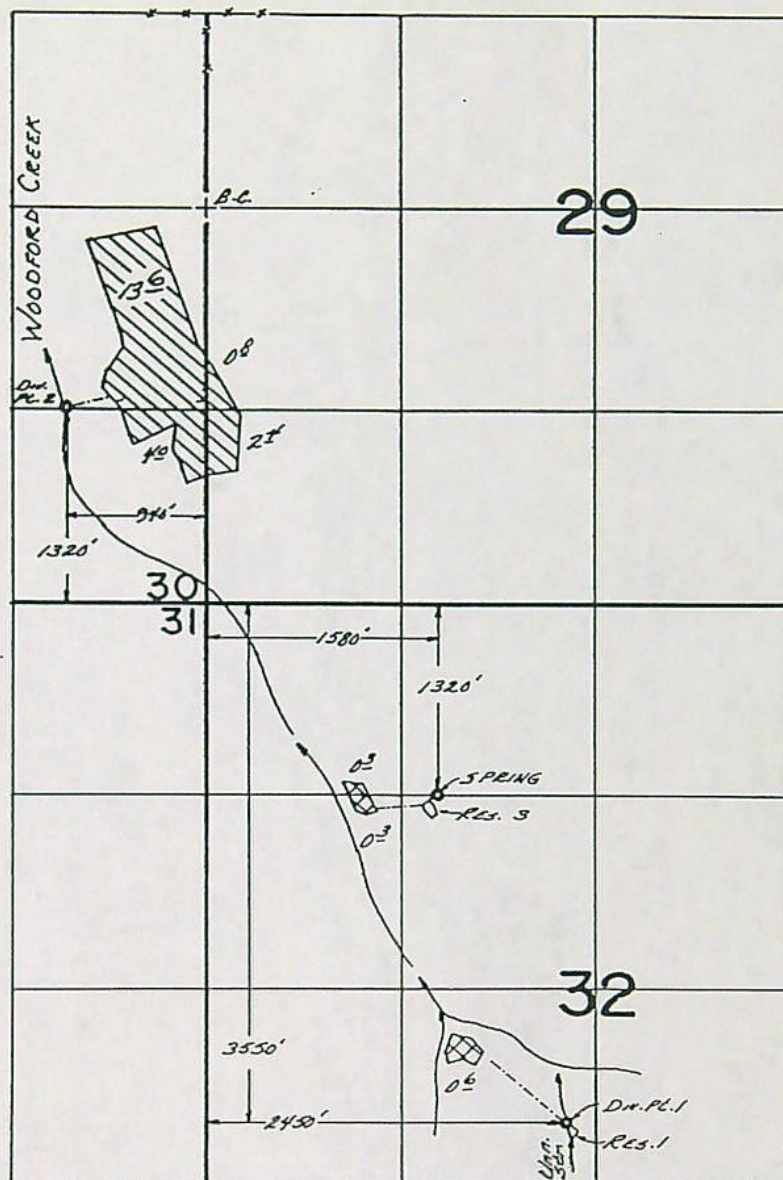

On February 6, 1970, The New Education Foundation filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of changes in points of diversion and places of use of water from springs, tributaries of Woodford Creek and Woodford Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Douglas County, Oregon, entered August 14, 1930, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Cow Creek and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the names of John D. Lystol and N. E. Stuvland for the use of the waters of springs, tributaries of Woodford Creek and Woodford Creek for the irrigation of 0.2 acre in NW¼ SW¼, 1.5 acres in SW¼ SW¼, Section 29, 0.5 acre in SE¼ NE¼, 13.8 acres in NE¼ SE¼, 2.4 acres in SE¼ SE¼, Section 30, 1.1 acres in NW¼ NW¼, 3.8 acres in SW¼ NW¼, 2.0 acres in SE¼ NW¼ and 1.5 acres in NE¼ SW¼, Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1890. This right is evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 9650, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated from points of diversion located S 47° E 780 feet from the NW corner of Section 32 being within the NW¼ NW¼; S 32° E 3420 feet from the NW corner of Section 32 being within the NE¼ SW¼; S 23° E 3600 feet from the NW corner of Section 32 being within the NE¼ SW¼; and S 33° E 4455 feet from the NW corner



of Section 32 being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , all within Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed changes in points of diversion and places of use of



water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Roseburg, Oregon, on July 8, 1970, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in The News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 13, 20, and 27, 1970. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster of District No. 15, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed changes in points of diversion and places of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

Leo M. and Jennie G. Allen, mortgagees of the land involved, have submitted written approval of the changes in points of diversion and places of use of water.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in points of diversion and places of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.


It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to John D. Lystol and N. E. Stuvland and recorded at page 9650, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled



and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in points of diversion and places of use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to The New Education Foundation confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially and the change in point of diversion.

was. Roy remembers some people ran a hose  
up the cr. and got enough water to run out  
of the hose onto the ground along the rows  
of the blueberry patch. But he was not involved  
in project and doesn't know about it.

A spring feeds lower Resv. (A# R-46697) and  
then is used on the blueberry patch.

Woodford Cr. is also used w/ pump & sprinklers  
on large hay field. App. Map shows ditch

Remarks: This ranch is, what would be called in some areas a "Hippy Comune". the population is transient with a minimal permanent staff. the ~~per~~ person who was working on the water rights died recently and left no written information. the new staff have no idea of what has been done in the past. Only one person has been on the ranch for any period of time (Roy) and he was not involved with the irrigation and only remember what he saw as he wandered around the ranch.

The irrigation of the big hay field is self-evident. The pump and pipe are in the field. I surveyed only those areas which can be hayed and do not have natural reprod evergreen in them as Ed said they only hay and do not pasture.

The irrigation of the blueberry patch also was evident. I can see where the plastic hose lay from Resv. to field

~~that~~ The upper hay field is not that clear. the area shows no clear irrigated area. I surveyed the end of a 1" C.I. pipe onto which has been fastened a garden hose (about 15' long) Also Roy could not point out definite irrigated area. Therefore I surveyed an area which Roy pointed out by saying "something like - "they watered that area there where I pulled those culvert pipes into." IT is a relatively flat area surrounded by the remains of an old fence next to a washed out Resv. (#2 on A# R-46697).

The 0<sup>2</sup> Ac piece filed on, had been a garden at one time. But it has not been used in many years. It is covered with wild strawberries, wild Rose and Reprod evergreen (Cedar & Fir) There is a spring and ditch system which could be used with only a little work. But, the people at the ranch didn't know about it. The discovered it when I pointed it out and asked about it. I did not survey it.

Summary

I could find only 1 div. pt. from Woodford Cr. now being used. It is the pump site for the big hay field. The ranch people said another had been used, but they had no idea where it is.

I could find only 1 spring being used, to fill lower Resv. I found another spring, but it is not now being used.



### Affidavit

I, Martha Walden, have resided on the property owned by Mountain Grove Center for New Education ("MGC") (formerly New Education Foundation) at 785 Barton Road, Glendale, Oregon for the past seven years with the exception of January, 1983 through May, 1984. During my residence there have been numerous gardening and farming projects on the land, some of which used irrigation from Woodford Creek. The large field at the north end of the valley was used to grow field crops of various vegetables such as peas and corn, as well as some cover crop grains such as rye during the summers of '80, '81 and '82. These crops and the apple orchard required irrigation. It was my impression that this practice had been ongoing for a number of years before my residence. In 1982 there was also a large garden in the upper meadow at the south end of the field which was also irrigated from the creek, using a gravity feed system.

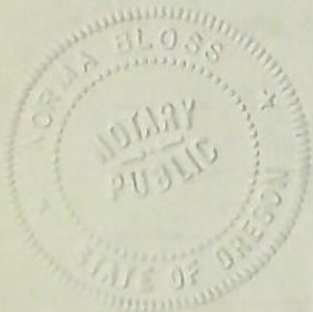

The farm was previously a cattle ranch and the former owner used the water to irrigate pasture land and to harvest hay. The soil is now very poor for our purposes. In 1971, we planted 5,000 ornamental trees costing \$900.00 as a cash crop, a dozen fruit trees, many vegetables, and we irrigated pasture for our cow.

In 1972, we planted 1000 one-year old and twenty-five three-year old blue berry bushes costing over \$400.00 (including pipe for irrigation in the northern part of section 32 - 1.4 acres) as a cash crop for later years. We've grown cow peas as a cover crop over additional acreage to enrich the soil.

We plan many more crops - raspberries and other berries, more vegetables, more ornamental trees, and several cereals. Each crop necessitates an expenditure of money and the soil needs much manure and phosphate rock which is expensive..

To harvest cereals we must purchase a combine and the ornamental trees are not yet large enough to sell profitably.

We just don't have the money to do a quick job of completion of beneficial use of the water.

We request that the time of completion be extended to Oct. 1, 1973.
