





ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2366

On April 24, 1970, W. T. Puderbaugh filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Hurricane Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Wallowa County, Oregon entered January 20, 1919, In the Wallowa River Adjudication proceedings, a water right was established in the name of F. H. Lamphear for the use of the waters of Hurricane Creek for domestic and stock use and the irrigation of 35.0 acres in SEM SWM, Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1896. This right is evidenced by certificate recorded at page 3081, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Robin Boner Ditch from a point of diversion located South 36° 31' West 588 feet from the WM corner of Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands by means of the Moonshine Ditch from a point of diversion to be located South 76° 02' West 49 feet from the NE corner of Section 3, being within the NE% NE% of Section 3, Township 3 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Enterprise, Oregon, on July 2, 1970, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the <u>Wallowa County Chieftain</u>, a newspaper

printed and having general circulation in Wallowa County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 7, 14 and 21, 1970. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Walter L. Astwood, Watermaster of District No. 7, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Hurricane Creek, to-wit:

From a point located South 36° 31° West 588 feet from the W/4 corner of Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., being within the NE% NE% of Section 35, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

To a point to be located South 76° 02' West 49 feet from the NE corner of Section 3, being within the NE% NE% of Section 3, Township 3 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 35.0 acres in SE% SW%, Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1896 is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 1½ acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary

to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to F. H. Lamphear and recorded at page 3081, Volume 4, State
Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon receipt of
proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized
change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued
to W. T. Puderbaugh confirming said change in point of diversion.


