





On December 13, 1954 Frank E. Price of Sunny Valley, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Grave Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered April 26, 1919, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and Its Tributaries, adjudicated a water right in the name of H. R. Nehrbas for the irrigation of, among other lands, 12 acres in the NE_4^1 NW_4^1 , Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M., from Grave Creek with a date of priority of 1891. These lands are irrigated through the Steam Beer ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 1800 feet north and 200 feet west from the South Quarter Corner of Section 12, and being within the NE_4^1 SW_4^1 , said Section 12, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate said 12 acres by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said pumping plant to be located 450 feet south and 850 feet west from the North Quarter Corner of Section 11, and being within the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, said Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was given in the Grants Pass Bulletin, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks, being the issues of

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2/21/1455 V 8pg 310-312 December 23 and 30, 1954 and January 6, 1955. The time for hearing as fixed in the notice, namely: February 20, 1955, was not less than thirty days after the last publication of said notice.

Mr. Tom R. Pearce, Watermaster of District No. 16, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Grave Creek may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Grave Creek, to-wit:

> From a point located 1800 feet north and 200 feet west from the South Quarter Corner of Section 12, and being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 12, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M.,

To a point to be located 450 feet south and 850 feet west from the North Quarter Corner of Section 11, and being within the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, said Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M.,

for the irrigation of 12 acres in the NET NWT, Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M., with a date of priority of 1891, be and the same hereby is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be done and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1955 or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster, it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the pumping plant be constructed at a sufficient distance from the stream to permit the construction of a headgate to regulate the flow of water from the stream to the pump sump and to install a weir or measuring device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the location of the pumping plant and channel to convey the water to the pump and the plans of the headgate and weir or measuring device be approved before the beginning of construction work by the watermaster of Josephine County, Oregon, and that the headgate and weir or measuring device be constructed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

These lands are irrigated by means of the Harkness Ditch from a point of diversion located 900 feet south and 450 feet west from the EX corner of Section 12 being within the NEX SEX of Section 12, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 570 feet south and 400 feet east from the S% corner of Section 2 being within the NW% NE% of Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W.M. NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Grave Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 900 feet south and 450 feet west from the E% corner of Section 12 being within the NE% SE% of Section 12, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 570 feet south and 400 feet east from the S¼ corner of Section 2 being within the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 0.9 acre in SE% SW%, 0.2 acre in SW% SE%, Section 2, 3.9 acres in NW% NE% and 1.3 acres in NE% NW%, Section 11, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1863, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1972. It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.


> That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to H. R. Nehrbas and recorded at page 16529, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Raymond H. Morris confirming said change in point of diversion.






