



ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2374

On May 8, 1970, Geraldine S. Bryant filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from East Fork Evans Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to J. N. Hockersmith and recorded at page 1997, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second of water from East Fork Evans Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 11.0 acres in NE% SE%, Section 20, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 27, 1913. These lands are irrigated by means of the Mayfield Ditch from a point of diversion located 300 feet south and 1200 feet west from the N% corner of Section 16 being within the NE% NW% of Section 16, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 700 feet south and 700 feet west from the E% corner of Section 20 being within the NE% SE% of Section 20, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on July 23, 1970, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the <u>Ashland</u> <u>Daily Tidings</u>, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 29, June 5, and 12, 1970. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from East Fork Evans Creek, to-wit:

> From a point located 300 feet south and 1200 feet west from the N% corner of Section 16 being within the NE% NW% of Section 16, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 700 feet south and 700 feet west from the E% corner of Section 20 being within the NE% SE% of Section 20, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 11.0 acres in NE% SE%, Section 20, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 27, 1913, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be

effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

> That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. N. Hockersmith and recorded at page 1997, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Geraldine S. Bryant confirming the change in point of diversion.





under Enlargement Permit No. 191 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 280 , on the 9th day of March, 1918 ; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from August 27, 1913 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Eleven acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; <u>nine</u> acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and <u>twenty-five</u>. acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty, Township Thirty-four South, Range Two West of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
