The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

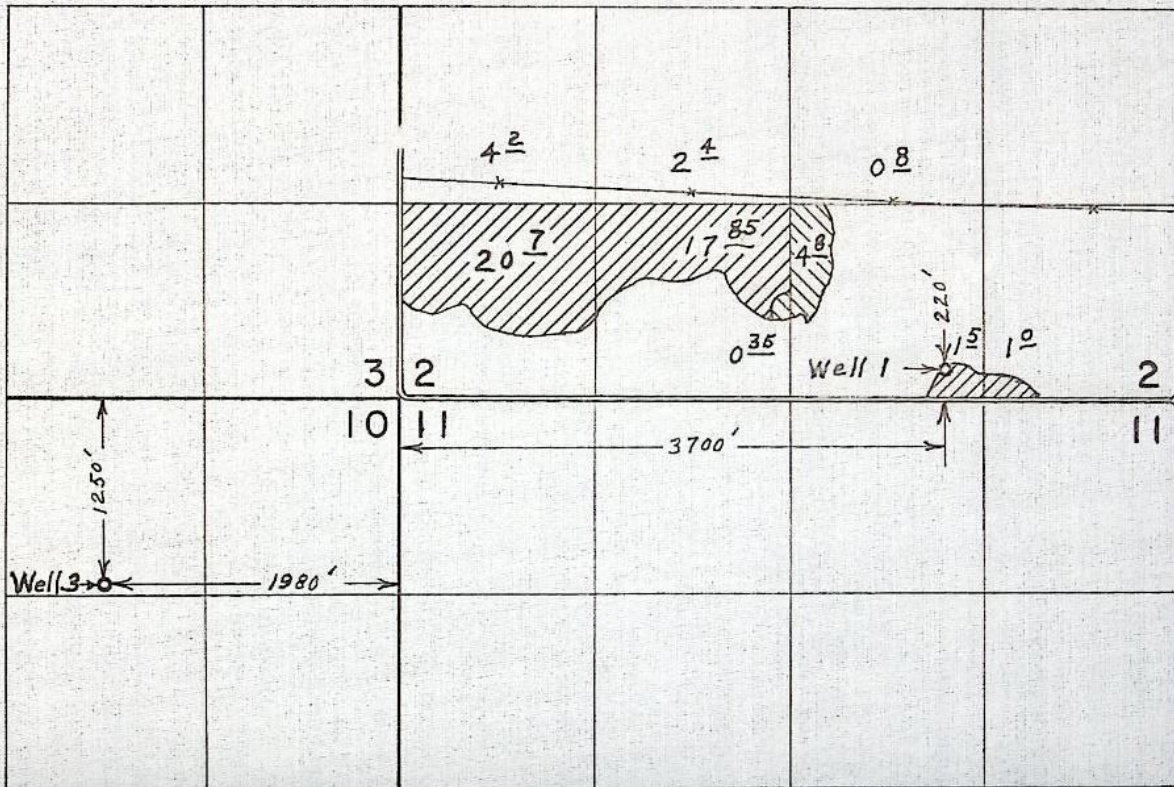

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 2, T 15 S, R 40 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 14.75 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 26.3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 40 East, W.M., with a date of priority of February 14, 1950, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 20.7 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 17.85 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 1.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 1.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 15 South, Range 40 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1971.

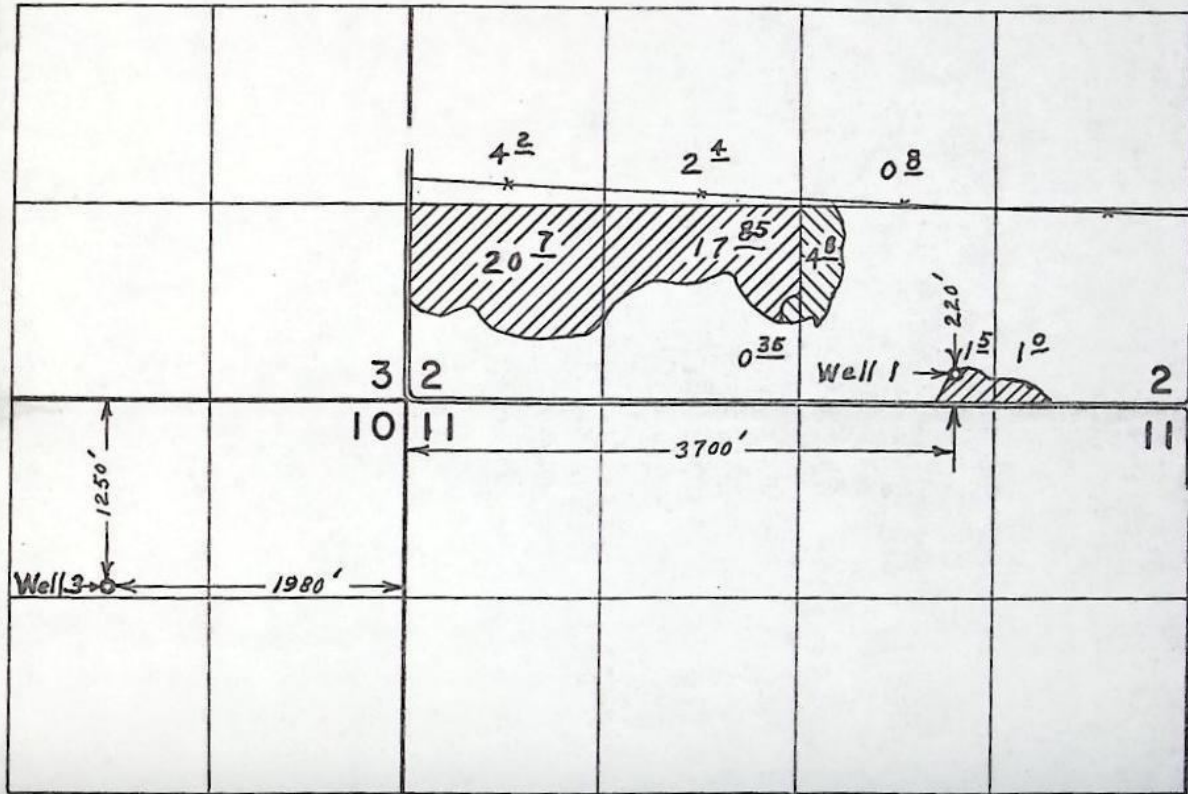

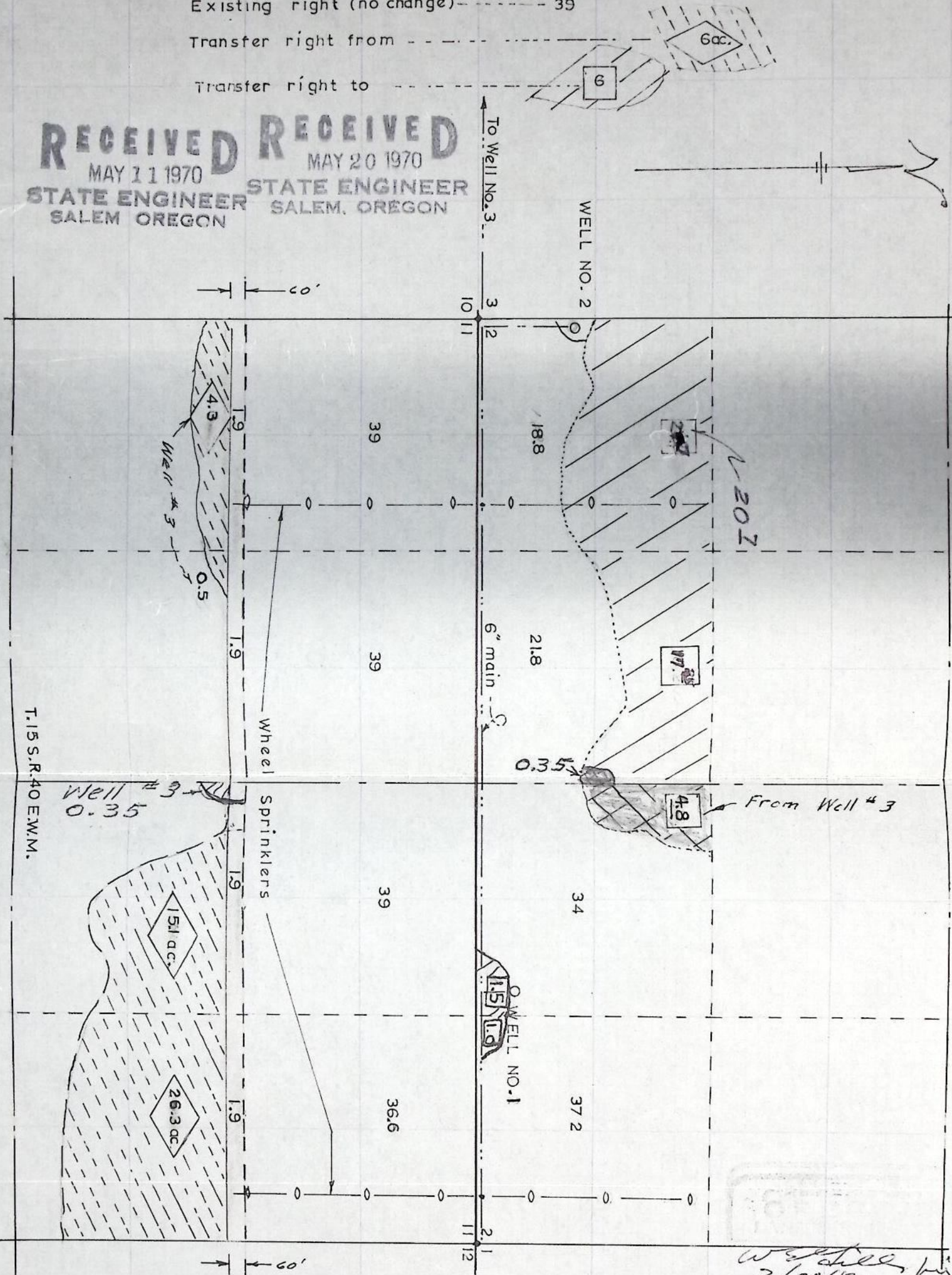
