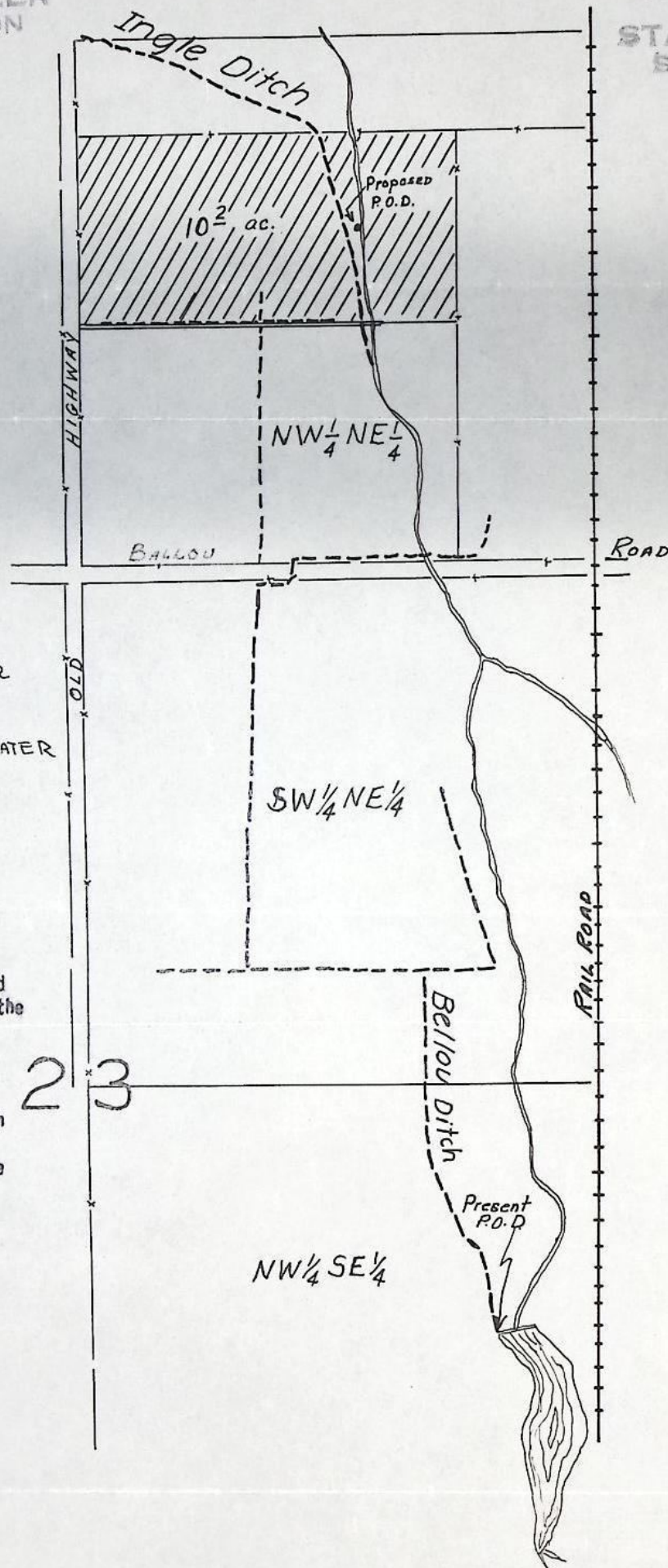

On May 15, 1970, N. Coffey filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from East Prong of Little Walla Walla River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Umatilla County, Oregon, entered May 16, 1932, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Walla Walla River and its Tributaries a water right was established in the name of A. L. Coffey for the use of the waters of East Prong of Little Walla Walla River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 10.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1892, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 12601, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Ferndale Ditch from a point of diversion located 700 feet north and 250 feet west from the SE corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 850 feet north and 585 feet west from the SE corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there

were, namely: at the county courthouse in Pendleton, Oregon, on July 22, 1970, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the East Oregonian, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Umatilla County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 26, June 2, and 9, 1970. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Jerry F. Haines, Watermaster of District No. 5, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from East Prong of Little Walla Walla River, to-wit:

From a point located 700 feet north and 250 feet west from the SE corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 850 feet north and 585 feet west from the SE corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 10.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1892, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed

one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to A. L. Coffey and recorded at page 12601, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to N. Coffey confirming the change in point of diversion.
