My husband, Olger G. Sether, passed away Oct. 25, 1975. Since I have turned everything over to my son. I wish to have his name put on this transfer.

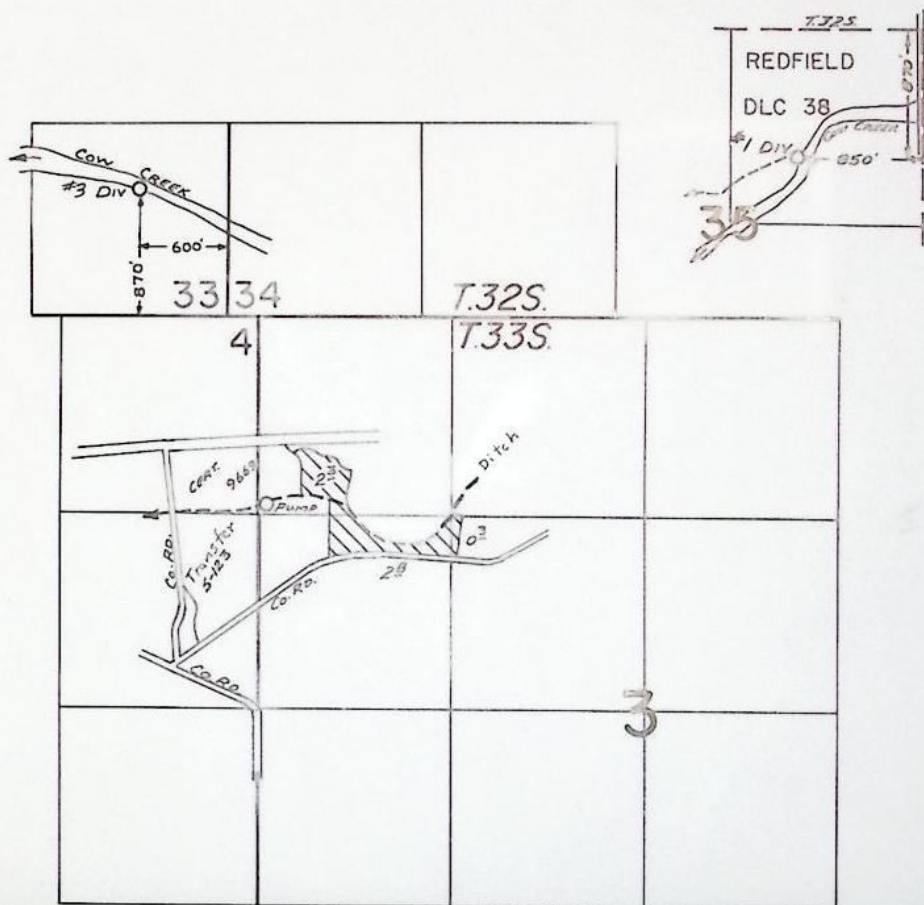

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 2486

On February 12, 1971, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John O. Sether for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from springs and a stream tributary to Cow Creek and Cow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 36030, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Carl J. and Olger Sether, and is for the use of not to exceed 1/70th cubic foot per second per acre from springs and stream tributary to Cow Creek and Cow Creek, under a priority date of September 17, 1903, for irrigation of a certain 11.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3; 30.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 2.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; 4.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, 7.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 14.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 32 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

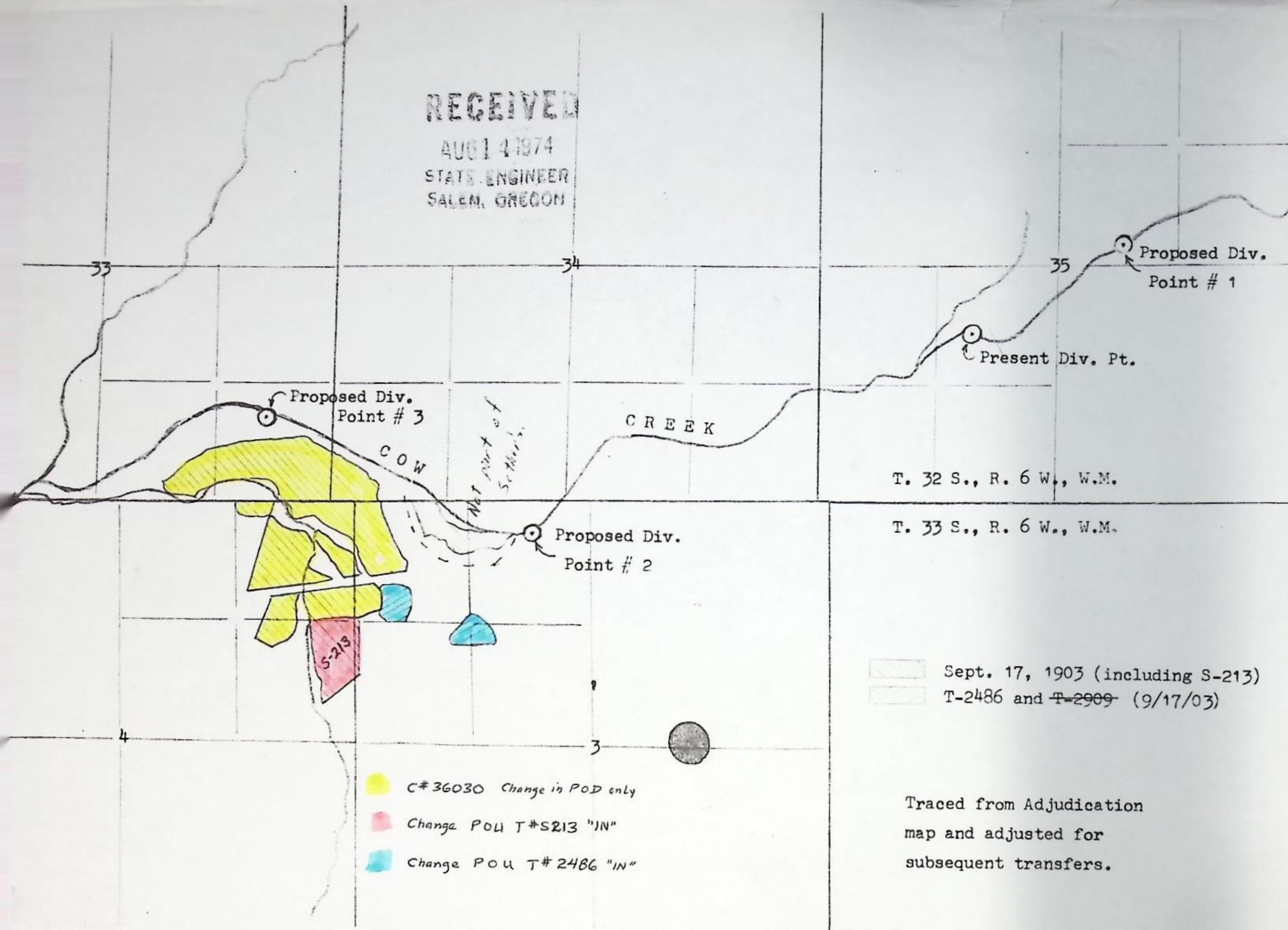

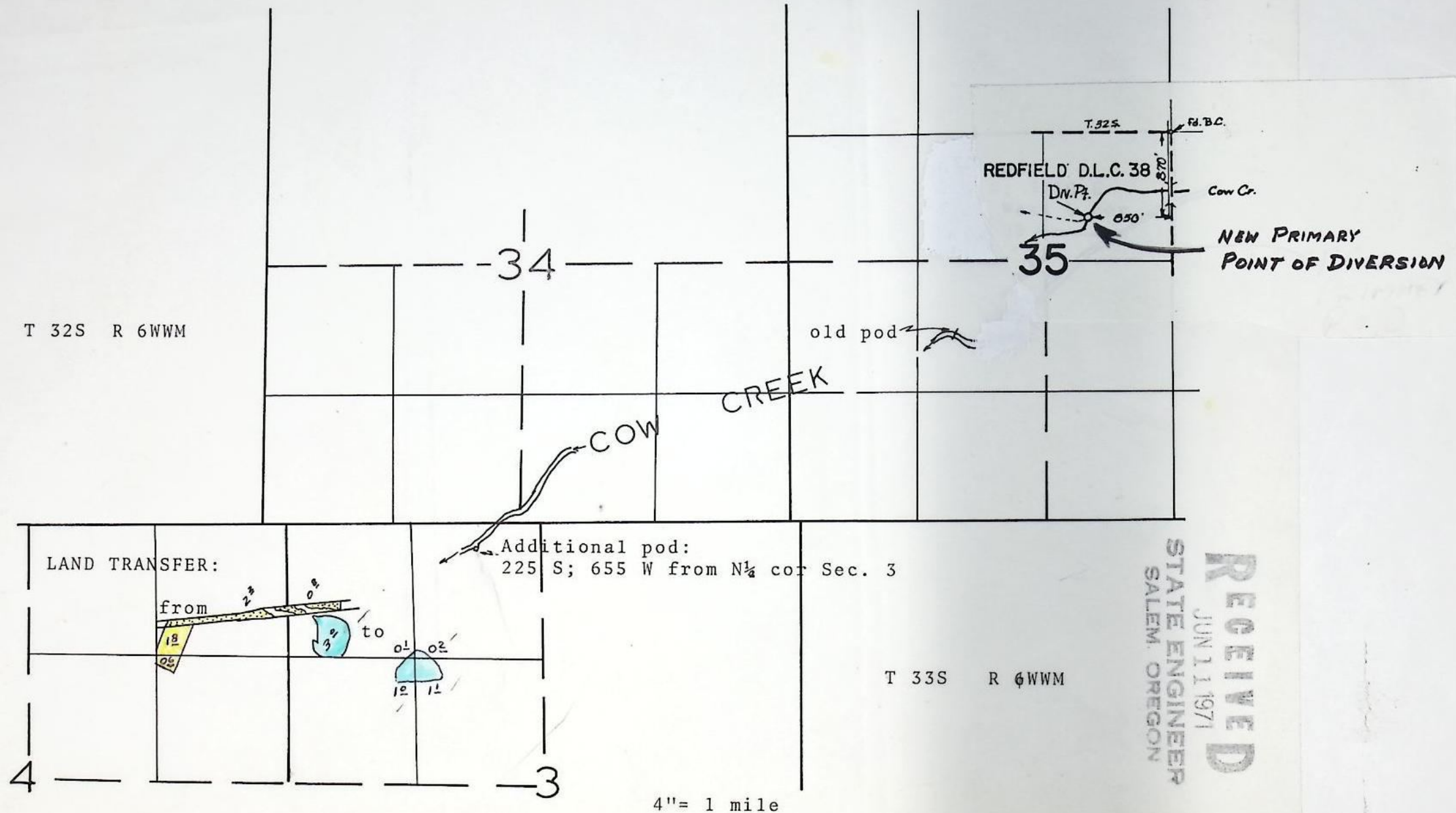

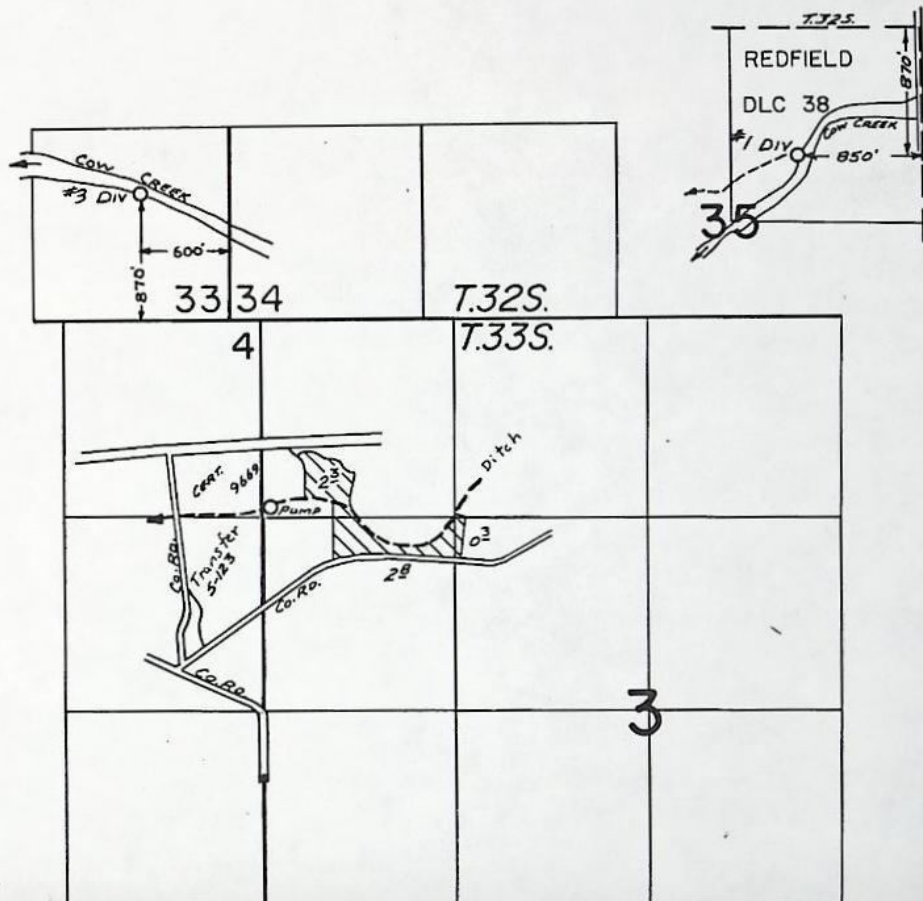

Remarks There is one point of diversion between the existing point of diversion and the additional proposed one. It is for A#29465 Which I own and hold.

#20 Continued: The application also includes a change in the location of the primary point of diversion. This change was completed several years ago when the ditch also served Mr. C.O. Garrett who has already filed for a completed change in point of diversion for his right. The additional point of diversion is needed during the early irrigation season and the last month of the irrigation season because in most years the flows of Cow Creek during this period are too heavy to install & maintain our summer diversion dam across Cow Creek at our primary point of diversion. We anticipate using the additional point of diversion almost every year.

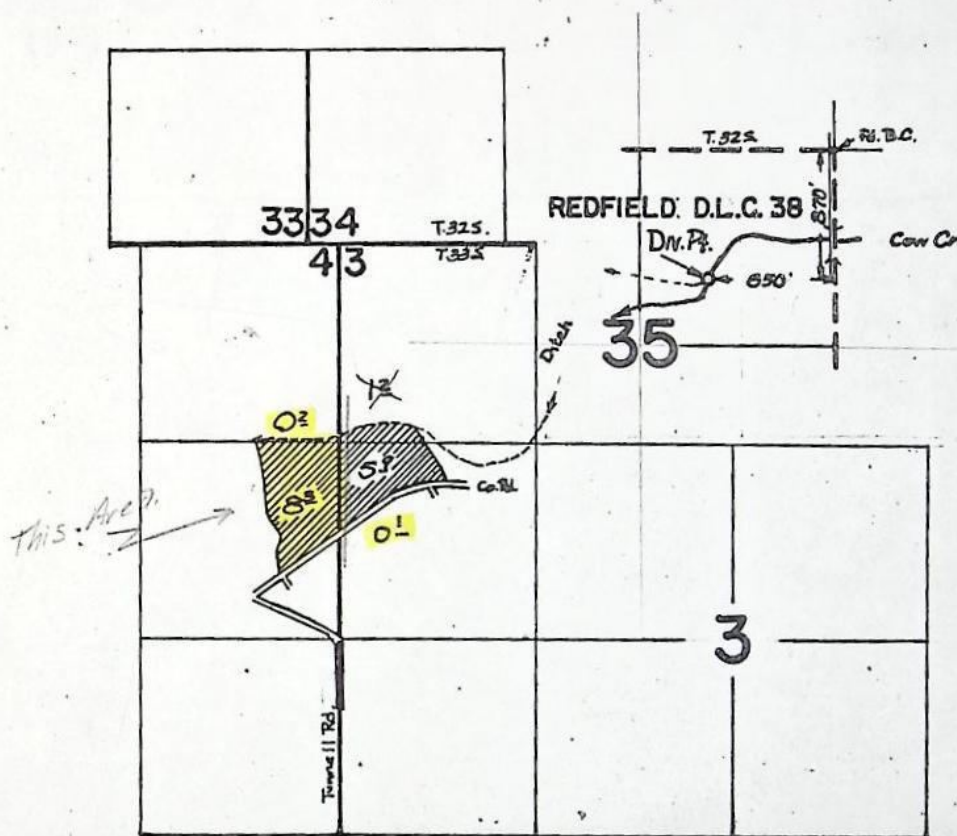

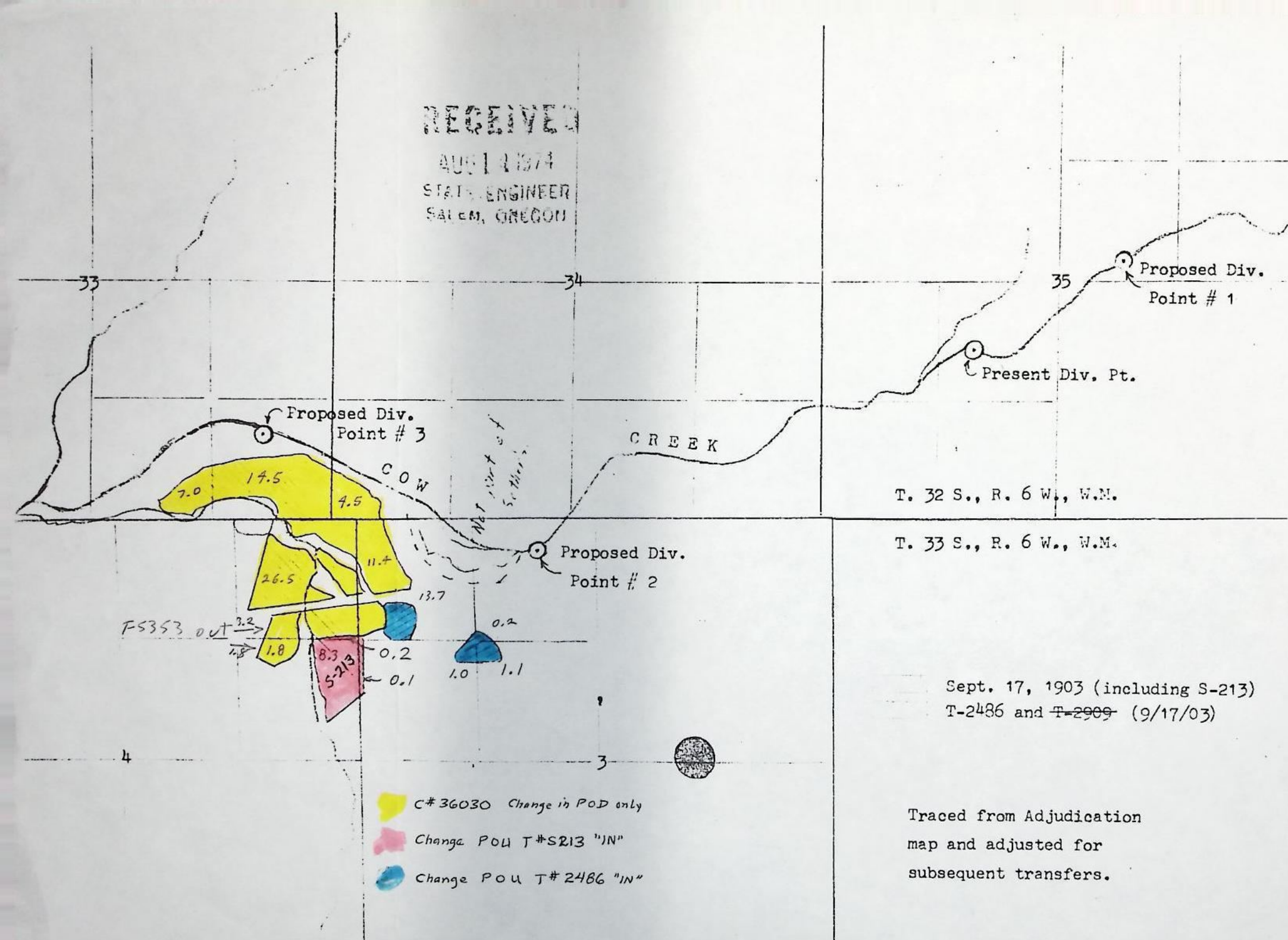

The affected water right is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 36030, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Carl J. & Olger Sether, and is for the use of not to exceed 1/70th cubic foot per second per acre from springs & stream tributary to Cow Cr. & Cow Cr., under a priority date of Sept. 17, 1903, for irrigation of a certain 11.4 ac in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec 3; 30.5 ac in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 2.4 ac in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec 4, T 33S, R 6W, WM; 4.5 ac in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec 34, 7.0 ac in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 & 14.5 ac in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec 33, T 32S, R 6W, WM.

SUBJECT: Transfer Application Number 2486

Gary Ball recently met again with John Sether in the field and I believe this transfer is now complete. Referring to your letter of January 6, 1977, the letter from Mildred S. Sether was correct in that after the passing away of her husband, Olger Sether, she wishes this transfer to be placed in the name John O. Sether.

You are correct in that there is probably little need for transfer #2909 as the lands for that transfer belong to a Mr. Ortman who is still using the ditch and does not wish to apply for transfer of water right at this time.

We have added P.O.D. #3 as shown on the map and the addition has been initialed by John Sether. The reason for each change in P.O.D. is as follows:

- P.O.D. #1: To move the original ditch diversion upstream to where it now exists.
- P.O.D. #2: Immediately above P.O.D. #2 there is a flume crossing Cow Creek. On certain years the water is too swift to install this flume yet irrigation is needed. The applicant proposes, at times, to pump water from Cow Creek into the ditch until he can install the flumes.
- P.O.D. #3: During the latter part of the summer, the applicant has found it convenient to utilize the ditch solely for the transportation of water to the upper fields and, in part, to supply Superior Lumber Company who has the Lystol Lawson right on the original ditch.

P.O.D. #3 is a pumping point which allows the lower field and, at times, the field immediately above the roadway, to be irrigated. Mr. Sether for example in 1977, during the extremely short water year, ceased to use the ditch completely, pumping only what water that was barely needed from P.O.D. #3 to minimize his effect on the stream. This is to allow more water to flow downstream for the City of Glendale. Glendale's water right is quite new and the only water they receive on extremely short years, such as 1973 and 1977, is return flow from the Sether Ditch or Superior Lumber Company. By utilizing P.O.D. #3 in the extremely dry years the Sethers can cut their water consumption well below the legal limits under their right of record.

Mr. Sether has indicated the News Review would be a suitable publication for the advertising on this transfer.

We recently received a letter from Mildred F. Sether advising that her husband, Olger G. Sether, passed away in October of 1975, and requesting that any pending water right matters be put in the name of John O. Sether. I checked the files and found three transfer applications that are pending in one status or another.

Transfer No. S-213, changing the place of use for 8.6 acres under the right evidenced by prior certificate No. 9669, has had the final proof survey made, but the certificate confirming the change has not yet been issued because these lands are involved in pending transfer No. 2486.

Said transfer No. 2486 also covers other lands evidenced by certificate No. 36030 which supercedes certificate No. 9669.

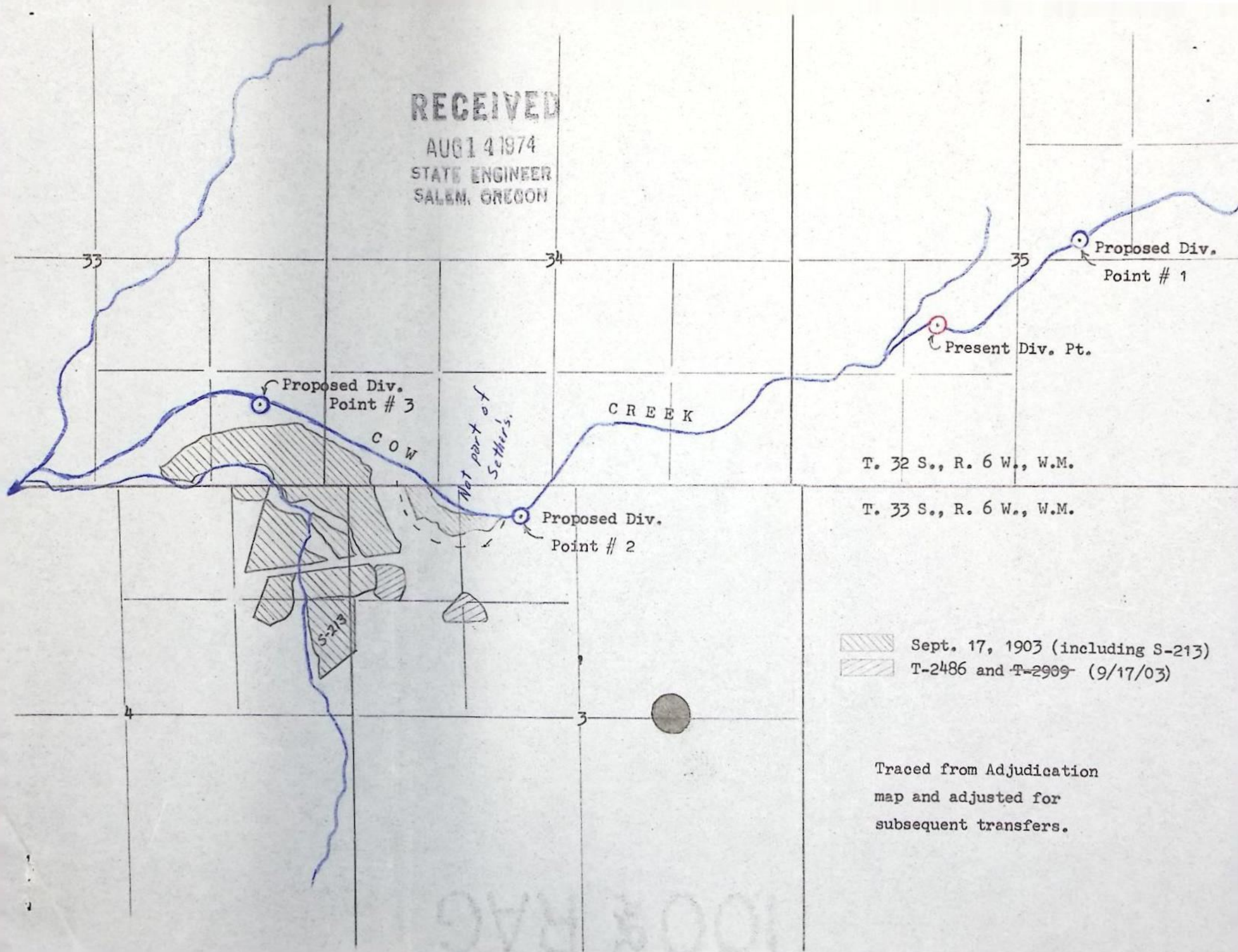
The third pending transfer application, being transfer No. 2909, was for a change in point of diversion for the water right evidenced by certificate No. 996 from Cow Creek with the priority date of November 18, 1909. Since all of the lands under certificate No. 996 are located north of Cow Creek and with reference to the enclosed copy of your memo of August 13, 1974, and the attached map, it appears that transfer No. 2909 should be withdrawn and any unearned fees returned to the Sethers.

With reference to transfer No. 2486, which is also enclosed together with maps and a marked copy of certificate No. 36030, I would appreciate it if you could go over the transfer application with John Sether and determine if it accurately described the changes in place of use and point of diversion that have been or will be made by the Sethers. If you will then return the application with any appropriate amendments and tell us which newspaper John Sether would like for us to use for publication of notice, we will proceed on this matter.

It is noted that the application proposes to relocate the point of diversion and to also establish one additional point of diversion. However, one of the maps enclosed indicates a proposed point of diversion No. 3. We would appreciate it if you could clarify this for us also.
