

Mr. Vestal R. Garner, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from South Fork Alsea River, to-wit:

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of September 6, 1946, and 0.20 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of May 5, 1941.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificates of water right heretofore issued to John Newman and recorded at pages 24389 and 24390, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, certificates of water right shall be issued to Bruce L. Engel confirming the change in point of diversion.


