On September 25, 1970, Oregon State Game Commission filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Cedar Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

for fish hatchery and domestic use in NE% NE%, Section 24, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 24, 1924, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed and the new diversion in operation.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning

of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.
