

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2456

On October 8, 1970, H. E. and Ruth E. Blanchard filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Berry Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Anton J. Paulson and recorded at page 22205, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second of water from Berry Creek for irrigation of 0.8 acre in E½ SW% NW%, 2.4 acres in E½ SE% NW% and 1.0 acre in W% NE% SW%, as projected within Berry DLC No. 42, Section 12, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 28, 1951.

By an order entered July 6, 1965, the State Engineer approved a change in place of use of water from the lands above described to the irrigation of 3.03 acres in NE% SWA, 0.2 acre in NW% SWA, 0.86 acre in SWA SWA, and 0.91 acre in SE% SWA, Section 12, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M. Satisfactory proof of complete application of water was submitted.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 0.97 acre in NE% SW% and 3.23 acres in SE% SW%, Section 12, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not

given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right here-inbefore described as appurtenant to 3.03 acres in NE% SW%, 0.2 acre in NW% SW%, 0.06 acre in SW% SW%, and 0.91 acre in SE% SW%, Section 12, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 28, 1951, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority, transferred to 0.97 acre in NE% SW% and 3.23 acres in SE% SW%, Section 12, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

The order entered July 6, 1965, canceled the certificate recorded at page 22205, Volume 16, and provided for issuance of a new certificate confirming the change in place of use approved by that order and including the balance of the lands not involved in the change.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no certificate be issued in accordance with the order entered July 16, 1965, and in lieu thereof a certificate of water right shall be issued to H. E. and Ruth E. Blanchard confirming the change in place of use of water herein described and including the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding.
