

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2459

On October 29, 1970, W. J. Roberts filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Thomas Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Peter W. and Amanda J.

Toews and recorded at page 30495, Volume 22, State Record of Water

Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.70

cubic foot per second of water from Thomas Creek for the irrigation of,

smong other lands, 6.7 acres in SW% NW%, 31.6 acres in SE% NW%, 9.4

acres in NE% SW%, and 2.3 acres in NW% SW%, Section 12, Township 10

South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 19, 1960.

These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located S 36%° W 10

chains from the most westerly SW corner of Haman Shelton DLC 41 being

within the NE% SW% of Section 12, Township 10 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, contract purchaser of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located S 58° 39' W 1105.5 feet from the most westerly SW corner of Haman Shelton DLC 41 being within the NE% SW% of Section 12, Township 10 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. Vestal R. Garner, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

Peter Toews, contract seller of the lands involved, has submitted written approval of the change in point of diversion.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Thomas Creek, to-wit:

From a point located S 36%° W 10 chains from the most westerly SW corner of Haman Shelton DLC 41 being within the NE% SW% of Section 12, Township 10 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

To a point to be located S 58° 39' W 1105.5 feet from the most westerly SW corner of Haman Shelton DLC 41 being within the NE% SW% of Section 12, Township 10 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 6.7 acres in SWA NWA, 31.6 acres in SEX NWA, 9.4 acres in NE% SWA, and 2.3 acres in NWA SWA, Section 12, Township 10 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 19, 1960, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line

flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Peter W. and Amanda J. Toews and recorded at page
30495, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the
balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt
of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the
authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right
shall be issued to W. J. Roberts confirming the change in point of
diversion.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.70 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE_{4}^{1} SW $_{4}^{1}$, Section 12, T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
