On December 14, 1970, Nelson C. and Howard O. Tribbett filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from a well, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Nelson C. and Howard D. Tribbett and recorded at page 30620, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second of water from a well for the irrigation of 4.9 acres in SWA SWA, Section 5, 0.3 acre in NEWA NEWA, Section 7, 1.2 acres in NWA NEWA, 23.0 acres in SWA NEWA, 24.6 acres in NEWA NWA, 35.0 acres in NWA NWA, 12.0 acres in SWA NWA, 32.2 acres in SEWA NWA, 3.0 acres in NEWA SWA, and 2.0 acres in NWA SEWA, Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 22, 1960.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to irrigate these lands from a well to be located N 67° 27' E 3340 feet from the NE corner of DLC 97 being within the SW% NE% of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. William B. McCall, Geologist for this department, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights if the new well will be developing water from the same ground water reservoir.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections to the proposed change in point of diversion having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from a well, to-wit:

From Tribbett Well No. 1 located 26 chains north and 10 chains east from the NE corner of Hickey DLC 67 being within the SW% NE% of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

To a well to be located N 67° 27' E 3340 feet from the NE corner of DLC 97 being within the

SW% NE% of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 4.9 acres in SW% SW%, Section 5, 0.3 acre in NE% NE%, Section 7, 1.2 acres in NW% NE%, 23.0 acres in SW% NE%, 24.6 acres in NE% NW%, 35.0 acres in NW% NW%, 12.0 acres in SW% NW%, 32.2 acres in SE% NW%, 3.0 acres in NE% SW%, and 2.0 acres in NW% SE%, Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 22, 1960, 5.4 acres in SW% NE%, 4.1 acres in SE% NE%, 0.1 acre in NE% NW%, 0.4 acre in SE% NW%, 2.0 acres in NE% SW%, 12.6 acres in NE% SE%, and 29.4 acres in NW% SE%, Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 28, 1963, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the new well shall be so constructed that water will be withdrawn only from the ground water reservoir which supplied the old well.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of July 22, 1960, and 0.67 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of June 28, 1963.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificates of water right heretofore issued to Nelson C. and Howard O. Tribbett and recorded at page
30620, Volume 22, and page 36298, Volume 28, State Record of Water
Right Certificates, are canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory
to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point
of diversion, certificates of water right shall be issued to Nelson
C. and Howard O. Tribbett confirming the change in point of diversion
and covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding.
