ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2691

On August 24, 1972, Mountain Fir Lumber Co., Inc. filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in use of water from Mayfield Spring, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to George C., Edwin B. and Ethel L. Mayfield and recorded at page 19585, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second of water from Mayfield Spring for the irrigation of 3.2 acres in SW_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , 2.1 acres in SE_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , 4.4 acres in NE_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} , 0.8 acre in NW_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} , 6.4 acres in SW_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} and 0.6 acre in SE_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} , Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W.M., with a date of priority of February 21, 1947.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the use heretofore made of water to industrial use for sprinkling log decks and other plant use in the SE_{ij}^{1} SW_{ij}^{1} of Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in use of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse at The Dalles, Oregon, on January 30, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in <u>The Dalles Chronicle</u>, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wasco County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of December 6, 13 and 20, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster of District No. 3, has filed

a report to the effect that the proposed change in use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in use of 0.38 cubic foot per second of water from Mayfield Spring from the irrigation of 3.2 acres in SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, 2.1 acres in SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, 4.4 acres in NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, 0.8 acre in NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, 6.4 acres in SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ and 0.6 acre in SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W.M., to industrial use for sprinkling log decks and other plant use in the SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W.M., with a date of priority of February 21, 1947 is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the use of water as herein described shall be limited to the irrigation season of each year.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to George C., Edwin B. and Ethel L. Mayfield and recorded at page 19585, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate shall be issued to Mountain Fir Lumber Co., Inc. confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
