CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

SHERRILL J. POHLMANN AND NYLLA WYN BANCROFT

3939 Fish Hatchery Rd., Grants Pass , State of Oregon, 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

under Permit No. 2805 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 13, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SEL SEL, Section 8, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Highland Ditch-60 rods West from the SE Corner, Section 8

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE's SE's, Section 8, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 780 feet North and 1540 feet East from the St Corner, Section 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 14, 1976 and together with certificates of water right recorded on Page 48256, Volume 41 and Page 44003, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 4921, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.



ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2693

On August 28, 1972, Sherrill J. Pohlmann and Nylla Wyn Bancroft filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Applegate River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Highland Ditch Company and recorded at Fage 4921, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirmed a right to the use of not to exceed 1.44 cubic feet per second of water from Applegate River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 30.0 acres in SE¹/₄ SW¹/₂, and 10.0 acres in SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 13, 1915. These lands are irrigated by means of the Highland ditch from a point of diversion located 60 rods West from the Southeast corner of Section 8, being within the SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 755 feet North and 1175 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 8, being within the SE4 SE4, Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said Section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there is no intervening diversion.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Applegate River, to wit:

From a point located 60 rods West from the Southeast corner of Section 8, being within the SE1 SE1 of Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 755 feet North and 1175 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 8, being within the SELSEL of Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 30.0 acres in SE_4^1 SW_4^1 , and 10.0 acres in SW_4^1 SE_4^1 , Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 13, 1915, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster. On September 10, 1975, an order was entered by the Water Resources
Director canceling part of the right evidenced by the certificate recorded at
Page 4921. Said order also canceled the certificate recorded at Page 4921 and
provided for a new certificate to be issued covering the balance of the right
not canceled.

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It is FURTHER ORDERED that the part of the right involved in the change authorized herein not be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered September 10, 1975, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the change in point of diversion authorized herein, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Sherrill J. Fohlmann and Nylla Wyn Bancroft confirming the change in point of diversion.
