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





The applicant herein, contract purchaser of the lands above described, proposes to discontinue use of the said two wells as the means of appropriation and, without change of priority, change the point of appropriation to obtain the water from the said aquifer for irrigation of all of the said lands by means of one well located 60 feet North and 2580 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 28, being within the SE4 SW4 of Section 28, Township 4 North, Range 27 East, W.M., Morrow County, Oregon.

Mr. Elroy F. McDole, title holder of lands above described, has given his approval to the proposed changes in point of appropriation.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Heppner Gasette-Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of September 9, 16 and 23, 1976.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster of District No. 5, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificates of water right heretofore issued to Elroy F. McDole and to E. F. McDole and recorded at Page 34281, Volume 26, Page 37054, Volume 29, and at Page 40855, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to J. ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On June 1, 1976, Mr. Roy Kilpatrick filed a petition for reconsideration of certain portions of the Water Resources Director's order of April 2, 1976, determining the Ordnance critical ground water area on behalf of J. W. Aylett.

The petition has been considered and the points raised are not well taken.

Paragraph 11 of the Conclusions, which petitioner complains of, together with paragraph 4 of the order, provide that application No. G-5684 may be approved or withdrawn upon request of the applicant within 60 days of the date of the order. While its approval is little, if any practical value to the applicant, it can be had upon request.

Petitioners attempt to infuse approval of an application for changes in points of diversion under several rights is also not well taken. The application (File No. TR-2649) for changes in points of diversion under several rights is being considered on its own merits as provided by ORS 537.705, 540.520 and 540.530. These sections set forth the statutory procedure for the Director to approve changes in use, place of use, or point of diversion of ground water, and must be followed. Such procedures include publication of notice, hearing on the question, and finding that the change can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the petition for reconsideration is hereby denied.
