

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

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROLLO L. KINTZ 1506 WILLAMINA AVENUE FOREST GROVE, OREGON 97116

confirms the right to use the waters of TANNER CREEK, a tributary of SCOGGINS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 6.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 13701. The date of priority is APRIL 24, 1939. The right is limited to not more than 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 1 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 680 FEET NORTH AND 20 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

N 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 6.8 ACRES SECTION 6 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 5, 1986, approving Transfer Application 5745, and supersedes certificate 41944, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2588

On November 23, 1971, Rollo L. Kintz filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Tanner Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Bernard van Meltebeke and recorded at page 13770, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 0.09 cubic foot per second of waters of Tanner Creek for the irrigation of 6.8 acres in SE% SE%, Section 6, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 24, 1939.

The applicant, herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority to 6.8 acres in North ½ of SE¼ SE¼, Section 6, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by DRS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved. NDW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 6.8 acres in SE% SE%, Section 6, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 24, 1939, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 6.8 acres in North ½ of SE% SE%, Section 6, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1972.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Bernard van Meltebeke and recorded at page 13770, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Rollo L. Kintz confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
