

On November 23, 1971, Irvin H. and Edna L. Elrod filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for a change in point of diversion of water from Big Butte Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Luke Ryan and recorded at page 37631, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 1.015 cubic feet per second of water from Big Butte Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 1.6 acres in NEW NWW, Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 15, 1913. These lands are irrigated through Ryan Ditch from a point of diversion located North 56° 3' West, 1170 feet from the SE corner of Section 3, being within the SEW SEW of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to divert the water through a pumping plant at a point of diversion to be located 780 feet South and 715 feet West from the North ¼ corner of Section 3, being within the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on May 24, 1972, at 9:30 s.m. The notice was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a

newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County,
Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 10, 17 and
24, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than
thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Big Butte Creek, to-wit:

From a point located North 56° 3' West 1170 feet from the SE corner of Section 3, being within the SE% SE% of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 780 feet South and 715 feet West from the North ¼ corner of Section 3, being within the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 1.6 acres in NE% NW%, Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 15, 1913, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.
