




Certificate of water right issued to Margaretha Schild and recorded at page 751, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.70 cubic foot per second of water from Munson Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 10.0 acres in SW4 NW4, 15.5 acres in NE4 SW4, and 17.0 acres in NW4 SW4, Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 9 West, W M., with a date of priority of June 15, 1910. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 3025.7 feet South and 3555 feet East from the NW corner of Section 28, being within the NW4 SE4 of Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to divert the water for irrigation from a point of diversion 252.98 feet North and 754.50 feet East from the West ¼ corner of Section 28, being within the SW¼ NW¼ of Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Tillamook, Oregon, on September 14, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the <u>Headlight Herald</u>, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Tillamook County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 20, 27, and August 3, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Clayton Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.
